I. Minutes



- 1. Area Director comments
 - a. Review last meeting Action Items
- 2. Area Treasurer Report (Trinidee Coleman)
 - a. Financial reports emailed out
 - b. Not much change going on right now
 - c. NAP compliance improving in the Area
 - d. Feedback from Christy is that the AYSO Office is late in uploading statements making it very difficult to follow up on deposits and bounced checks
 - e. B of A and Chase are closing bank accounts if the accounts are not "Business" accounts and sending the money to the AYSO Office.
 - f. Charlie recommends that if you are charged a fee, go in and request the fees be waived.

ACTION: RCs need to verify that their bank account are "Business" accounts

- 3. Area Referee Report (Wayne Hale/Bob Wright/Dave Coleman/Tim Haddad)
 - a. Report sent out
 - b. Planning for Advanced Referee Course in December on east side, would like to have an Intermediate class at the same time.
 - c. Intermediate Course scheduled for west side on Aug 3-4
 - d. Upper division mini-tournament Aug 24-25
 - e. VIP course on Sep 23 in Hesperia
- 4. Area Tournaments Report (Dave Coleman)
 - a. RCs voted to leave pool play the same as we have done before (no seeding)
 - b. Tournament guidelines remain the same
 - c. Mini-tournament Aug 24-25 at LNSC, 1st week of Aug will begin planning the tournament. Need team counts.
 - d. Will also need home field availability to schedule matches for the season
 - e. There will be travel across the Area, will try to limit to only a couple of times
 - f. Rocky All the RCs present are involved with upper division. We have a situation where the 19U division has precious few players, especially on the east side.



Polled the 6 RCs involved regarding the 17U player from Palmdale playing on a 16U co-ed team. Playing "down" involves restrictions: 1) Can only play during the regular season against those regions that agree; 2) No opportunity for this player to participate in post season (Area/Section playoffs, or 16U tournaments). Hesperia also has two (2) 17 U players. Is there an opportunity to perhaps merge VV, HES, TC 18U team? TC registration is still open for a couple more weeks – expect ~100-150 players to register. Numbers unknown right now. If R878 17U players play down, they will have same restrictions on post-season play as imposed on R393 17U player. Action for R393 and R878 RCs: Obtain written acceptance from family of each 17U player playing "down" that they understand and agree to the post-season restrictions stated above.

g. "Crystal ball" estimates: VV – 18UB, 2-18UG, HES – 16UB, 19UG (need to find home for 2-17UB players); QH – 19UB, 2-16UB, 3-16UG, 2-19G; LANC – 16UB, 19UG; TC – 19UB, 19UG; PLM – 16UB, 16UG (19 teams in upper division for Area). Going to reach out to Area S to see if QH 19UB can play there, and to reach out to Section 1 for the VV and TC 19UB teams to have more opportunities to play.

ACTION: Rocky to reach out to 10S for opportunities for 19UB, and to Section 1. **ACTION:** Final team counts by Aug 7 and field availability from RCs, any conflicts (e.g., coaching multiple teams)

5. Area Coach Report (Scott Jones/Tonya Clark)

Western – Rosamond, Cal City, Lancaster, Quartz Hill, Palmdale (Scott)

- a. Started getting classes going (63 coaches through this last weekend, 80% of the coaches were from QH)
- b. Reached out to the other regions to try to meet their needs
- c. Rocky is requesting that the regions respond to Scott/Tonya on yes we need help, or no we are fine. **No response is not acceptable**.
- d. Intermediate course is scheduled; will need 30 players (14U players)
- e. Trying to get an Adv course in early September
- f. 6U 12U coach classes scheduled at AVC on Aug 3-4

Eastern – TriCom, Victorville, Hesperia (Tonya)

- g. Want to get with the Coach administrators to find out what they need
- h. Having difficulty in getting upper division coaches in TriCom



- i. Coach Instructor course tentatively scheduled for September 22 (Sunday).
- j. Prerequisite Intro-to-Instruction course scheduled for September 20 (Friday evening). All future AYSO instructors (Coach, Referee, Mngt) are welcome to attend!!

Action: Luisa to reserve venue (Sunset Ridge) for Sept 20 (Friday evening 3.5 hours) and Sept 22 (Sunday 8am to 5pm).

- 6. Area Management Report (Rocky Kovar)
 - a. Report sent out
 - b. 4 RCs (Lanc, Plm, TC, Ros) have terms that are expiring. Paperwork should start 6 months before the next term is to begin. RC re-appointment requirement: All seven (7) board positions must be filled with trained volunteers (includes the RC who must complete the RC training weekend)
 - c. NO WAITLISTING of players. No penalty for over-rostering your teams.
 - d. Volunteers need to follow through on the email from the third party (Sterling) to complete their registration. Rocky will send all RCs a list of the volunteers that have not yet completed the full registration process. REMEMBER: No volunteer may participate in any AYSO activity (coaching, officiating, management) without first fully completing the registration process AND passing their background check for each membership year.

ACTION: Each RC to review volunteer list and make sure each volunteer has fully completed the registration process.
