- 7. Region Updates
  - LANCASTER
    - Player count: 420 players (up by 100 over last yr) 45 teams, all have coaches, waiting for background checks and training. When LiveScan record uploaded, they "shrink" to an unreadable size. Planning on keeping a copy of the fingerprinting records. Received \$20K grant from City of Lancaster.

#### PALMDALE

 Met with most of our coaches last night. Missing 5-6 coaches for 45 teams (410 players). Uniforms are in. Will hand out in a couple of weeks. Starting practice in a couple of weeks.

#### TRI-COM

- Currently at 350 players (down 119 from last year). Don't have team numbers yet, only have 22 players in 10UG. May have to travel to Hesperia and VV to get games in. Have a lot of 6U and 8U players. Purchased an AED for their fields. Holding off practices until next week. Moving to a new vendor for uniforms away from Score.
- QUARTZ HILL



 106 teams (1200 players). Hard to get upper division coaches. Score uniforms with Microsoft logo. 4 teams at National Games. Mandating each team has one referee, not including the coach. Working on inter-region play with Lancaster and Palmdale

#### VICTORVILLE

#### CAL CITY

o 77 players registered, 7 teams. 10U is the largest group. Registration is still open until Aug 11. Coaches meeting held today. Treasurer and CVPA volunteers have been recruited. Ordered soccer balls and jerseys – due Aug 22<sup>nd</sup>. Kickin Sports USA is the vendor for the uniforms. Rocky to help set up access to AYSO systems for her Treasurer and CVPA.

#### ROSAMOND

318 last season, 327 players, approximately 45 teams. Started first practices tonight. Sharing field space with football. Still missing two coaches – 12UG and 10UB. Coaches meeting on August 9<sup>th</sup>. Had planned a Referee course on Aug 26<sup>th</sup>, but may move this to not conflict with the course at LNSC.

#### HESPERIA

 Just started practices. In the process of doing roster releases. Had coach meetings a week ago. Had to go above the desired roster size. Around 1000 players, 2 EXTRA teams, and EPIC. Struggling with getting 14UB coaches. 130 on a waitlist due to lack of coaches. Onboarding new board members.

#### 8. Other Business

- a. CPR training for region volunteers (Mike Bryant) can provide the training but cannot be under the AYSO umbrella.
- b. Interest to have AED units at region fields (10D, 10S). AYSO Office (Risk Mngt) working on policy/solution to have partner company lease/train/maintain/track AED units for placement at region fields throughout AYSO.
