1) Section 10 Updates and Information

 - Youth Intermediate Referee Camp: Cancelled
 - Youth Regional Referee Camp: three 1-day camps: Camarillo – August 10; August & September – Fillmore, Santa Barbara
 - Intermediate Referee Course - September, Ojai to host
 - 2025-26 Key Law Changes
 - 8-second goalkeeper control
 - Goalkeepers have 8-seconds to release the ball once they have clear control.
 - Referees will signal the final 5 seconds as a public countdown serving as a warning to prevent time wasting.
 - If the goalkeeper exceeds the time limit , the restart is a corner kick for the opposing team.
 - Dropped ball.
 - Which team has possession or clearly would have gained possession is a criterion to determine who receives a dropped ball.
 - Outside the penalty area, the restart occurs where the ball was when it was stopped versus when it was last touched.
