



AYSO Area 11L Tournament Reminders



Important Reminders:

- Pets (i.e. dogs) are **NOT** allowed at any field or match (per AYSO National Organization).
- Chairs, tents, benches, umbrellas, etc. are NOT allowed on the synthetic turf fields at the Lake Forest Sports Park.
- Coach and Assistant Coach ID Cards must be worn and remain visible during all Matches.
- Coaches are required to have in their possession, **AT ALL TIMES**, copies of each players current Spring Season Player Medical Release Form.
- Minimum Required Play Time
 - No player may play 4 quarters until **ALL** teammates have played at least 3 quarters (including goalkeeper) unless prohibited by roster size.
- Pool Play Match Duration:
 - 10U = 2 x 25min halves
 - 12U = 2 x 25min halves
 - 14U = 2 x 25min halves
- Championship and Consolation Match Duration:
 - 10U = 2 x 25min halves
 - 12U = 2 x 30min halves
 - 14U = 2 x 35min halves
- Pool Play tie breaker criteria:
 - Winner of head-to-head competition (not used if more than two teams tied)
 - Fewest goals allowed
 - Winner of most games
 - Greatest number of shutout victories (wins only)
 - Fewest number of blowout matches (max goal differential allowed 6)
 - Coin Flip
- Standings for pool play games will be determined using the “three-point system”:
 - WIN = 3 points
 - TIE = 1 point
 - LOSS = 0 points
 - FORFEIT = 3 points (scored as a 1-0 win)
 - SEND OFF = 1 point deduction for each send off of a player or substitute
 - EJECTION = 1 point deduction for each ejection of a team official or spectator
- Referee Deposit Refund
 - ~~A minimum of six (6) Tournament Pool Play referee positions are required to be covered in order to receive a full Referee Deposit Refund. Tournament Referee Refunds will be calculated using only the qualified referees submitted via the Tournament registration application.~~
