Setup and Tear Down of Nets/Goals/Corner Flags:

Coaches/Teams with the FIRST game of the day are required to retrieve from appropriate location and set up goals/nets (In some situations the goals/flags will be pre-delivered to the field).

Coaches/Teams that play in the LAST game of the day are required to tear down and take goals/nets to the appropriate location.

Matchtrak indicates first and last games on your schedule, see icons below. Please refer to Matchtrak for setup and cleanup days, web address will be forward to Coaches and Team Managers prior to the season.


Matchtrak Icons

St. Maria Goretti Goal Storage:

Please GENTLY roll the goals (after flipping over the wheels) to the northeastern portion of the parking lot after the last match of the day. The corner flags can be carried to the blue container located along the south wall, to the west of the fields. Whoever is assigned to shut the facility down will lock them up in the container. If you have extra help, we also need to dump our grey 114 trash cans and leave them close to the container for lock up and make sure the restrooms are clean.

Monroe Goal Storage:

After the last match of the day, please GENTLY roll the goals (after flipping over the wheels) to the southwest corner of the school, near the entrance closest to Harvey Way. The goals are stored "kissing" each other with the 4 corner flags in between the goals.

McBride Goal Storage:



U9/U10 Field (Field 1)

After last match of the day, please GENTLY roll the goals (after flipping over the wheels) and push up against the green fence area along the north perimeter of the school (See picture)

*We do not currently have a place to store corner flags at this location. They will be brought over each week from Heartwell.

Full-Size Field (Field 2)

After last match of the day, please GENTLY roll the goals (after flipping over the wheels) and push them up against the southeastern perimeter of the chain link fence (See picture).



Storage Container at McBride







The container is located on the walk as you enter from the parking lot. As you make the right hand turn to go to the fields it will be on your left.

To open the box - The lock is located on the front left side of the box. Enter the combination, push the lock in and pull out on the silver tab. The lock is captured and will not come out of the hole. Scramble the numbers on the lock immediately so no one can get the combination. Then slide the latch pin to the left to unlock the door. Lift up on the black bar on the face of the box to open the lid.

To close the box – Lower the lid. Make sure that the face is back against the box. Slide the latch pin to the right. Lift up on the handle to make sure the latch is engaged. Push the lock into the hole until it clicks. Pull gently on the silver tab to check that it is locked. Check that the latch pin WILL NOT move to the left.

The box should contain the following items. 8 red corner flags, 2 white signs, 2 yellow parking signs, cones, paint and paint machine.
