John Muir Goal and Field Set-Up Guidelines fall 08v1

Location: John Muir Elementary 6560 Hanover Drive San Jose, CA 95129 (Park on Wisteria Drive – It is the street closest to the playing field)

Set Up Goals for all teams with game times that start at 9:00 AM

NOTE: Please arrive 30 minutes before game's start time to allow enough time to set up the goals properly. If your team's game is the last game of the day, then you will need to stay ~20 minutes after the game is over to allow enough time to help take down the nets and goals, store them and Ref Field Bags and make sure everything is properly cleaned/locked up before leaving the field!

- 1. Unlock the goals from the fence using **combo (unpublished). Be sure to relock the chain** to the fence to prevent them from getting lost or stolen!
- 2. Pull goals away from fence and tilt them forward. Grab middle of top bar and drag them into place. If it is too heavy for some grab a volunteer two people can easily handle the weight.


Deploy Nets, Stake goals, corner flags, Ref Field Bag & Garbage Cans:

- 1. Unlock storage shed using same combo (located at southwest entrance to the U8 fields along Wisteria drive) and the garbage cans chained to fence using **combo**. Be sure that the **locks are** relocked during the games to prevent the locks from being lost or stolen.
- 2. Unlock the Port-o-Potty (use same combo)
- 3. Corner flags are inside the Goal shed deploy to each field and install one flag per corner. Simply push into the ground with your foot until the post stands erect and is stable.
- 4. Take net basket out of shed and walk them over to each goal. Install each net with bungee fasteners to goal post. Use about 13 bungee cords per net.
 NOTE: Look for the black Sharpee pen marks (marked with a "b") along the goal posts and use the marks as guideline placements for the bungee cords to attach the net to the goal post.
- 5. Hammer 4 stakes on to each goal (2 on the left and 2 on the right and 1 center back for the net) to anchor down the goal post's base; there are 10 stakes & a hammer located inside each Ref Field Bag. Hammer 1 stake in the center back of the net at the back of the goal so the net Is taut (tight) and not too loose. Tuck nets under the left and right sides of goal post.
- 6. Put 1 Ref Field Bag behind each field's goal net that is closest to the shed side of the field ice packs are in the side pockets.
- 7. Take garbage can liners from dispenser box in Goal shed. Put new garbage can liners inside each trash can that is locked to the fence.

Muir Field Take down: for All teams who are last scheduled on each field Last game start times are 2:00 (

- 1. Remove all 10 goal stakes and put them back in the respective Ref Field Bag.
- 2. Remove nets but <u>leave bungee cords attached to goal nets</u>. Put nets in basket then put the basket back in Goal shed.
- 3. Store goals along fence, lock them down. Please make sure all the goals are **LOCKED**.
- 4. Store the corner flags & Ref Field Bags in Goal shed.
- 5. Lock up the Port-o-Potty!
- Lock down the sheds! Make sure all lids and doors are closed snugly. Put the lock through
 the <u>bottom hole</u> to minimize the ability to lift the shed's lid up/open which will help to avoid
 vandalism and theft to our sheds.
