

ORDINANCE NO. 08-714

AN ORDINANCE TO ADDRESS THE USE OF BICYCLES AND PRESENCE OF DOGS IN PARKS FACILITIES AND THE OCCUPANCY OF VEHICLES PARKED IN PARKS FACILITIES BY AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 1, SECTIONS 106 (SUBSECTIONS 9 AND 10) AND 108 (BY ADDING SUBSECTION 7).


WHEREAS, the operation of bicycles and other wheeled riding vehicles and the presence of dogs in certain areas of parks operated by the City of Goodlettsville present hazards to and increase the risk of harm, injury or damage to park facilities and park visitors, and

WHEREAS, vehicles parked in park facilities for long periods of time during which the vehicle operator or occupant is merely sitting in the vehicle and not participating in any park related activity in any way or fashion has a detrimental effect on the level of enjoyment of most park visitors and in some cases interferes with normal parks operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF GOODLETTSVILLE, TENNESSEE THAT TITLE 2, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 2-106 (9) AND (10) ARE DELETED IN THEIR ENTIRETY AND A NEW SUBSECTION (9) IS ADDED AND READS AS FOLLOWS: "NO BIKES OR DOGS ON TRAILS, OR IN SPECTATOR, BLEACHER, PRACTICE OR GAME AREAS".

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED THAT A NEW SUBSECTION, SUBSECTION (7) IS CREATED AND ADDED TO TITLE 2, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 2-108 THAT READS AS FOLLOWS: "NO PERSON SHALL CONTINUOUSLY SIT LONGER THAN SIXTY (60) MINUTES IN A VEHICLE PARKED IN ANY CITY PARK".


THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT FIFTEEN (15) DAYS AFTER FINAL PASSAGE, THE WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF GOODLETTSVILLE REQUIRING IT.
