Albany Fields Coordinator

The Albany Field Coordinator is responsible for the allocation and maintenance of all playing fields, including practice fields, at Timber-Linn Park. Assists the Safety Director in ensuring a proper and safe playing environment, arrange for field and equipment maintenance, organize and supervise the volunteers in laying out and making the fields, and maintaining facilities. Helps with organizing any beautification projects and works with Albany Parks to determine any maintenance needs and shortfalls.

Regional Secretary

The AYSO Regional Secretary helps to organize and schedule Regional meetings, record the minutes of the Region meetings and transcribe them for distribution to the Regional staff, and attend Region meetings to record minutes and perform other duties as needed. The Regional Secretary must be a registered volunteer, should be able to attend Regional Board meetings (about 8 per year both online and in person), have good computer skills, and be able to take notes at the regional board meetings.
