



# Coach Instructor Course Region 815 Policy

Once you have taken the one-day classroom portion of the course, to complete the process you must instruct at a 12U Coach Course and be evaluated by an Advanced Coach Instructor.

You must receive a “PASSED” evaluation for instructing in the classroom and field modules of a 12U Coach Course and have completed all prerequisites. The evaluation form then is submitted to the Section 1 Coach Administrator who then has the candidate’s certification updated from the roster from “In Progress” to PASSED.

## Completing the Requirement

Please contact your Regional or Area Coach Administrator to help set up your Classroom & Field module evaluation at a 12U Coach Course.

## Classroom Modules:

Coach Instructor candidates must participate in administering the 12U course quiz and should help explain clarify or justify a portion of the questions or answers.

The candidate must also instruct either the “Coaching Methodology” or “Quality Training” from the 12U course PowerPoint presentation.

## Field Session Modules

Coach Instructor candidates must conduct one of the Instructor Model Activities with a focus on technical development. Candidates must also conduct either the Stage 2 or Stage 3 portion of the course training session.

## Prerequisites

1. Attended and received credit for AYSO Introduction To Instruction.
2. Are currently registered as an AYSO volunteer.
3. Attended and received credit for a 6U-12U Coach Course.
4. Completed Safe Haven certification.
5. Completed CDC Concussion Awareness certification.
6. Completed Safe Sport Training.
