Out of Region Play (OORP)

Out of Region play is decided by Region 73 Board for 2025/2026 10U-19U divisions. It's another way to continue to coach soccer once the fall season finishes. To qualify coaches, referees, parents, and players need to be in good standings with the Region. The 1st OORP form (pre-check) must be filled out by the coach and returned by October 12th, 2025 to R73 Regional Commissioner.

Area 10A tournament- Is by invitation only by Region 73

- For qualifying teams they must meet all requirements.
 - Coach(es)
 - Coach(es) has all their volunteer courses completed.
 - Coaching License for the age group they are in.
 - Complete; SafeSports, Background, Fingerprint, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
 - All courses are done online on AYSOU page.
 - Coached 75 percent of the Fall Season.
 - Have a minimum of two team referees and have all their volunteer courses completed.
 - Referee certification minimum Regional Badge.
 - Complete; SafeSports, Background, Fingerprint, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
 - All courses are done online on AYSOU page.
 - Misconduct reports may disqualify a team for invitation.
 - Obtain sponsorship of \$300 or more. We not recommend team self-sponsoring.

Section 10 League Championship- Is by invitation only by Area 10A.

- For qualifying teams they must meet all requirements.
 - Coach(es)
 - Coach(es) has all their volunteer courses completed.
 - Coaching License for the age division level they coach.
 - Completed: SafeSports, Background, Fingerprint, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
 - All courses are done online on AYSOU page.
 - Coached 75 percent of the Fall Season.
 - Have a minimum of two adult team referees trained and certified *)
 - Referee certification Regional Badge level or higher.
 - Completed: SafeSports, Background, Fingerprint, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
 - All courses available online with AYSOU button in your account.

- Misconduct reports may disqualify a team for invitation.
- *) Certified means can demonstrate sufficient competence for the job.

Allstars team- Is taking your Fall Season team or selecting players from other teams that played in the Fall 2024 Season by hosting tryouts.

A Coach is allowed **one (1)** Out Of Region (travelling) Play Team per AYSO year. **Example:** if you receive OORP approval for a 12UG team then you will not receive OORP approval for coaching another travelling team until July next year.

- To qualify for an Allstars team, coaches submit 1st OORP (pre-check) on time and:
 - o Head Coach (HC) has all volunteer courses completed
 - Coaching License for the age group they are coaching.
 - Complete; SafeSports, Background, Fingerprint, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
 - All courses are done online on AYSOU page.
 - Assistant coach (AC) required.
 - Same requirements as for Head Coach.
 - o Have a two/three referee team who meet all requirements.
 - Completed: SafeSports, Background, Fingerprint, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
 - All courses are done online on AYSOU page.
 - Regional referee badge or higher.
 - Officiated a minimum of 75 percent of games in the Fall Season.
 - Players in the team must have played 75 percent of the Fall Season Games.
 - o For Tournaments there will be fees, such as;
 - Tournament registration fees, Referee deposit, and traveling expenses.
 - To offset the cost for tournaments there are some options:
 - Team Sponsorship.
 - Sponsorship-T Form must be filled out and indicate the teams name and the tournament information.
 - Doing fundraisers helps;
 - o Pay for team uniforms, tournament fees, ref deposit, ect..
 - Uniforms must meet AYSO requirements and regulations.

Payments received to get a Region check to pay for the tournament fees must be consolidated in one check. Consolidated Payment Form (CPF) must be filled in and if parents contribute they must complete an <u>Individual Payment Letter (IPL) with the</u> exact amount they contribute. The CPF must match exactly the total of individual contributions. NO sponor money included. Checks to be made payable to AYSO Region 73.

Region 73 has developed a tournament info packet for the coaches with a checklist to help with OORP qualification.
