



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

(for Fall 2023 Season)

1. How much do the board members, coaches and referees get paid?

All of us are volunteers and do **NOT** get paid.

AYSO is an ALL Volunteer Organization and we need as many parents as possible to volunteer each year.

2. When does the season start?

Practices will hopefully start in early-August (as long as we have coaches) and games will start first Saturday after Labor Day.

3. How much are the registration fees?

Early registration of \$120 until June 7, 2023

Regular fee of \$135

Priority Registration ends July 7, 2023.

All registrations after July 7, 2023 will be \$160 per player. **Do not wait till then to register your child as they will not be guaranteed to be placed on a team.**

4. What does the registration fee include?

\$20 non-refundable AYSO yearly membership fee per player

A uniform: Jersey, Shorts, Socks

A picture packet: 1team picture, 1 button of your player, 3 wallets

Liability insurance

Training Classes, materials, equipment for coaches AND referees

5. How do I register my child?

You can login if you already have an account or click on the register now tab on top right of screen.

6. Do I have to live in SOUTH Ontario to play?

You do not have to live in SOUTH Ontario, or in any part of Ontario. You can live in any city and still play in our region.

7. What does my child need to play soccer?

Your child will need shin guards, closed shoes, a ball and always bring water. (size 3 for 8U and under | size 4 for 10U & 12U | size 4 for 14U and above)

8. Where are the games and practices played?

ALL practices are at Ontario Soccer Park, 2200 E Philadelphia Ave

Games for 10U and under are at the park as well

For 12U & 14U, depending on the number of registrations, might have some games at our sister region AYSO67 @ Ayala Park in Chino, CA

For upper divisions 16U and 19U, we play with 7 other regions (Chino, Diamond Bar, Chino Hills, Claremont, Hacienda Heights, Walnut, Covina)
