- The season will run from July thru end Oct.
 - o Tentative schedule: Beg of games: Week of Aug 29 | Area playoffs: Week of 10/31 | Section playoffs: 11/12-11/13
 - This division may practice two weekdays for 2 hours each.
 - There are not enough goals for every team. You and the team(s) around you MUST share the goals. They can't be moved.
- Players MUST ALWAYS have shin guards during practices & games, or they can't participate!!
 - Players are not allowed to wear jewelry of any kind during practices or games this includes earrings.
 - o Bullying of the opposite team or teammates will not be tolerated.
- Player FORMS: Must ALWAYS be with the coach, or in their absence, the asst coach or team manager ONLY (if they completed certs)
- REFEREES are needed to play games! Each team needs to provide 3 AYSO certified Intermediate referees to officiate the game when at home. Please ask parents for help! Please reach out to Erica A./RRA for any Qs 714-290-0412.
 - o We will hold a roundtable for current referees to precent updates to the law on

- Team Name: This year, each team will have a name of a country participating in the World Cup
- Banner: It's optional, but your team has to pay for it.
- Uniforms: NOTHING may be added to the uniform. Ex: players name, nickname or team name. This is for the player's safety and is a national guideline set by our national office.
- No pets of any kind or size are allowed in the park
- No sunflower seeds or any shelled nuts are allowed within the park
- The coach will hold a parent meeting before the start of the season to provide important information
- Your team needs a Team Manager! This person is to provide support to the team:
 - They will pick up and hand out uniforms, make a snack schedule, schedule pizza parties, coordinate a banner...
 - o A Volunteer Requirements Session will be held Aug 1 @ 6pm at West Wind, to help your volunteers complete their certs
 - A Team Manager meeting will be on Aug 4 @ 8pm at our OSP. Uniforms will be handed out. ONLY if ALL your volunteers have completed ALL courses
- Medals are handled by area, and will be awarded only to the teams that end up in finals
- OPENING CEREMONY is Aug 27. Ontario Police Department will provide FREE breakfast snacks (quantities are limited).
 - There will be skills clinics, team contest and raffles for a set of 4 tickets to a Galaxy game on Sep 17.
- Picture Day is Oct 1, all day. Games will be held on this day. MAKE UP DAY is TBD
- If new players are added to the team, our Registrar or your division Commissioner will be letting the coach know. **Do not let any players play in your team** without the Registrar or you Div Comm giving you the Medical Release form.
