



REGIONAL COMMISSIONER SELECTION PROCESS

for the term

April 1, 2026 to March 31, 2028

Overview: This document describes the process Region 2 will follow to select the next Regional Commissioner.

Selection Committee: The selection Committee will be chaired by outgoing Regional Commissioner Tom Denison, with Committee Members Laura Lim, Community Admin, and Jennifer Salisian, Regional Registrar.

Process:

- October 13, 2025 - Announce the Regional Commissioner position is open for nominations.
 - The open Regional Commissioner position will be posted to the region's website and an email will be sent to the region's participants.
 - Nominations should be emailed to the Selection Committee at rcselection@ayso2.org
 - All nominees will be asked to confirm their interest, and if interested, to fill out a nomination submission form.
 - All candidates will receive a copy of the Regional Commissioner's job description (attached).
- November 1, 2025 - Nominations are due by 11:59 PM to allow adequate time to complete the vetting process.
- November 6, 2025 - the Regional Commissioner Selection Committee will review and confirm the board member listing to determine a) which Board Members are in good standing; and of those, what the count of attendees is required to have a quorum. Those confirmed in good standing will be registered voters.
- November 9, 2025 - Proxy Form is due to Regional Commissioner Selection Committee by November 9, 2025 at 9PM.
- November 10, 2025 - Board members may vote in-person, or give a proxy vote to a present member. Members with proxy votes will not count towards quorum.



At the November 10, 2025 Board Meeting:

- The candidates will be introduced to the board.
- Each candidate will speak to their qualifications and goals for the region.
- Q&A to follow. Any additional questions from the Board or the Region should be emailed to rcselection@ayso2.org
- The Regional Commissioner Selection Committee will report on each candidate's qualifications, and any interviews or additional information.
- A quorum is required for the vote to take place. A secret ballot will be performed. Qualifying proxy votes and in-person votes will be included in the count. The Regional Commissioner Elect must win by a simple majority vote (50% of the votes cast + 1).
- The Regional Commissioner Selection Committee will oversee the process, count and confirm the votes, and announce the new Regional Commissioner Elect.
- The Regional Commissioner Elect will begin their term on April 1, 2026.
