Player / Parent / Guardian Agreements — All-Star Team 2025-2026

Welcome to the Palmdale AYSO Region 393 All-Star Tournament Season. Participation in this program is an honor that requires a high level of commitment from players, parents/guardians, team staff, and the regional board. To ensure a positive and successful season, it is crucial that all parties understand and agree to the expectations outlined below.

By signing this document, Players and Parents/Guardians acknowledge the following:

Commitment to the Program

- Player/Parent/Guardian Commitment: Participation in the All-Star and Tournament season demands significant commitment. The player and their family commit to fully engaging with the Palmdale AYSO Region 393 All-Star/Tournament team for the 2025-2026 season. When All-Star games conclude, the team may transition to a Tournament team, which will be self-funded. The team may apply to attend tournaments within or outside of our region, area, or state, and this will require additional support from families.
- Attendance and Punctuality: Players are expected to attend at least 80% of all practices, clinics, and games, and arrive on time. Failure to meet attendance requirements may result in reduced playing time or removal from the team.

Organizational Commitment

Players, parents, and guardians must adhere to all AYSO, Region 393, or host region rules, regulations, and standards.

Volunteer Commitment

Palmdale AYSO Region 393 is a volunteer-run, non-profit youth soccer association. All parents are required to participate in volunteer duties as directed by the host region/area/section and Region 393 guidelines. These volunteer responsibilities are in addition to team-specific duties or fundraising efforts. Neglect of these responsibilities may result in sanctions, including suspension from the team.

Playing Time

AYSO mandates that "Everybody Plays" at least 50% of each game they attend. Late arrivals will be required to play 50% of the game time they are present. Playing time beyond 50% is at the coach's discretion.

Sportsmanship

Players and families are expected to demonstrate positive and respectful behavior towards coaches, teammates, referees, and others. Failure to uphold these values may result in dismissal from the team without a refund.

Player Fees

Families are responsible for covering all financial obligations, including tournament fees, as set by the region and tournament host. Tournament fees must be paid 60 days prior to the tournament, payable to AYSO Region 393. Additional costs may be incurred if the team transitions to a self-funded Tournament team.

Time Commitment Expectations

Frequent participation in practices, games, and volunteer roles is essential. Families must be prepared for the following:

- **Increased Practice Frequency**: Practices may occur multiple times per week, with additional clinics or scrimmages.
- **Travel Commitment**: Tournaments may take place in various locations, requiring travel and potentially overnight stays.
- **Volunteering**: Parents will be required to assist with volunteer tasks beyond what is typical in regular-season play, including field setup, field monitoring, refereeing, snack duty, or fundraising efforts.
