Permits Report (Steve)	Almansor Permit pending for August 4 to third week of March 2025 Gave Carey picture day date of 9/28/25 - for old 10U side Opening day 9/6/25 Sierra Vista extended through August 31 Barnes permit valid through December 31, 2025	
Area 1C Report (Christina)	<p>AED update: AYSO now has a dedicated lobbyist to investigate the impact of AEDs on organizations like us that have multiple parks etc. The name of the lobbyist was not known by Rolando and those that attended NAGM didn’t hear the name at the meeting.</p> <p>Last year there were over 20,000 on the waitlist nationwide, Section is requesting heavy volunteer recruitment to prevent this high number from happening again.</p> <p>Upper Division: R60 is required to participate or Area 1C won't have enough 16U teams to move forward. Coach and Referee meetings are being split up this year. Coach meeting on 8/18/25 and referee on 8/20/25.</p> <p>When incidents occur it’s strongly suggested that regions have a panel that includes a referee, a coach and the CVPA. CVPA should be the one collecting the information and coming back to discuss with the rest of the panel to give the RC possible solutions or support for due process/appeals. Strongly suggested to request non board members to be on panels.</p> <p>Referees should be encouraged to report abuse and submit formal complaints.</p> <p>Reminder that as teams are built to make sure section playoffs rules are being followed, ex. If you are adding 14 players but section playoff rules state 12 player roster in December only 12 will be on the roster.</p>
