Used to be around \$500 per year, now close to \$10,000 for Barnes (M-F) and Sierra Vista (M/W/F). ● Ynez Kidd field & Mark Keppel for the Spring ● Robot and Cart maintenance fees <p>Motion by Steve to make Core Registration \$180 and Early Bird discount \$20 off. Second Kristy</p> <p>Motion by Steve that Early Bird period 3/15/26-3/31/26. Second by Kristy.</p> <p>It was discussed and decided not to put up the city street banners in Monterey Park and Alhambra, as rates have gone up and we have other plans for promoting registration.
