# **Regional Commissioner**

## Expo:

- Mojo App
  - Scheduling
    - Once we have our rosters set we can populate the schedules in Mojo which will then be available to coaches and families
    - This will happen outside of SportsConnect
  - Training Plans
    - Division-appropriate training plans will be available to coaches
  - Cost
    - There is no additional cost to our region, the cost will be covered by the \$25 National fee
  - Plan to pilot the app in the Fall
- Treasurer's Roundtable Attended by Mike and Kajsa
  - The use of electronic payment systems like Square, Zelle, and Venmo were discussed at the session
  - Zelle cannot itemize sales however, we could keep track of sales by other means and reconcile afterward

#### **Fields Discussion:**
