Meeting called to order by Mike Courtial at 7:06 pm. May Minutes approved: Eric 1st Corey 2nd and all approved.

RC REPORT:

Set player numbers to account for even teams. Numbers are looking at just under 1000 players, without Epic. Need some ideas for in person event, a roundup of coaches and refs in July. Thinking maybe a food truck event with player evaluations?

Looked into ordering region pins, can be passed out during games based on sportsmanship the Refs view of the game. <u>Attached Quote</u> <u>Pin View</u> Eric Motioned to purchase 1,000 pins national, then within region use: for \$1,471.33 not to exceed \$1,500: Eric 1st Robert 2nd Passed

Field Demo for robot went great, robot painted a 7v7 80x50 yard field in approx. 17mins. Rep will send over numbers this week for us to look over. Big plus aside from the purchase of robot the paint purchase would be nearly cut in half. EX: 2 cases paint (24) cans equals a gallon of paint, each case is about \$55 or \$110 for 2. Upper JW and GA will take that to paint. Pre-mix jug (gallon) runs about \$60. Rep said he saw one region purchase it at \$45. Paint is water based so disposal is easy. Outright purchase approx. \$17K. Following year and there after it's an annual fee of \$1800 for warranty and updates to tablet. Tablet uses cell reception vs base stations. If finance the price, does jump to approx. \$5 per which includes finance charges and \$1800 Service. Upper field about 25minutes to complete
