



2018 Rosamond AYSO Referee Point System

All teams 10U and up must provide certified referees to officiate regular season Rosamond matches in order to be eligible to participate in playoff games beyond the regular season (Area, Section, and beyond).

Rosamond Region 827 has established a point system to determine eligibility for post-season play. Referees earn points as follows:

Referee an 8U match =	1 point
Asst. Referee (AR) =	1 point
Referee 10U, 12U, or 14U =	2 points
No-Show for scheduled match =	-1 point
New Referee Certification =	2 points (Maximum 6 pts/team)

Each team may earn a maximum of 4 points per week. Referees may, and are encouraged to, do additional games during a week. However, the team will cease to accumulate points after earning 4 points.

The MINIMUM a team must acquire during the regular season to be eligible for playoffs is ...

20 points.

Points may be accumulated in any combination as specified above. Youth referees (12 & Up) ARE eligible to earn points for your team provided they are properly certified, in proper ref attire, and fulfilling the duties of a referee/AR. A club linesman is not eligible to earn referee points. Several referee training classes will be available leading up to and during the season. DO NOT WAIT until the end of the season to get certified and attempt to make your points; I hope no team has to explain to their players why their winning team will not be allowed to go to playoffs.

A Basic (Regional) Referee class takes 1 day, it is FREE, you will be provided lunch, and certifications do not expire. Register through <https://aysou.org>.
