## **Sportsmanship Points in Competitive Divisions**

Sportsmanship points will affect team standings. The affect will manifest itself in two ways.

- 1. The percentage of sportsmanship points will affect the total points in a team's standings. On a weekly basis, the percentage of sportsmanship points will be multiplied by the total standings points. A team with no deductions loses no standings points. A team losing sportsmanship points will lose points in the standings.
- 2. If, at the end of the season, a team has earned less than 95% of its possible sportsmanship points, it will not qualify for the playoffs.

## Sportsmanship points deduction guidelines

If necessary, the **Referee** will deduct sportsmanship points at the end of the game. **Referees** and **Coaches** *should be aware of the following guidelines* regarding the number of points to be deducted for certain violations.

- Sportsmanship points may be deducted for any poor performance in a category. For example, unacceptable spectator dissent could result in a deduction of 1 or more points in the "Spectator conduct" category.
- Deduct 1 point from "Player conduct" or "Coach conduct" for **each Caution** issued.
- Deduct <u>all 5 points</u> from "Player conduct" or "Coach conduct" when a **Send-Off** is given.
- Give a score for each category, then total them up. The total should not be greater than 23 points.
- If <u>2 or more</u> points are deducted from any category, an explanation for the deduction is required.
