General Assumptions around Coaches:

- Intentions are to have a positive impact
- Committed to doing the best job we can
- Want to build a winning team
- Competitive by nature

General Assumptions around Players:

- Enjoy the sport
- Like to be on a team
- Possess a wide range of talent
- Approach the sport differently depending on talent, confidence, parental influence, gender, and age
- Interest wanes with increased age for a wide range of reasons





- Approximately 30 Mentors will be trained in the coming weeks by PCA specialists
 - ANYONE interested in being part of the mentoring team, see us after meeting
- Mentors will show up at games, listen and use worksheet.
- After game, if there is time, they will review their notes with you (5-10 min) providing useful tips. If coach is in hurry, we will email you notes or find an alternate time to talk.
- Many coaches will not see a mentor due to resources but hopefully we will hit at least 60%.
- Focus will be on the U10-U14 divisions



What to Expect From Mentors



- Mentors include volunteers from the coaches, refs, board members, and AYSO alumni. They are YOU AND ME.
- Mentors are NOT there to help you coach, to be disruptive, to embarrass, or even be critical.
- They are there to observe and offer tips to help you be more aware and help create the most positive interactions possible which leads to more success and a better experience for the kids.
- A mentoring session should be a helpful experience for you and one we want you to embrace. It is not punitive.

Adoption of USSF PDIs



- USSF has instituted player development initiatives in younger divisions
 - Small-sided games, kick-ins, build-out line, no punting, ...
- AYSO nationally adopted these PDIs last year
 - PDIs taught in some coach classes
- R18 will implement them this year



U7 and U8 PDIs




- No heading
- No punting or drop-kicking
 - Keeper can throw or kick from ground
- No offside
- No build-out-line
- All free kicks are indirect
- 7U no throw-ins; instead pass-ins from side-line
- 8U throw-ins

Referee Scheduling



- Home Team provides one CR and one AR for the match AFTER their match (just one CR in U7/8)
- Visiting Team provides the second AR for the match AFTER their match (not in U7/8)
- Referee Points System in U10, U12, U14 modifies this obligation
- All referee assignments are filled via Referee Scheduling System (RSS)
 - Your team's volunteers must assign themselves in the RSS so we know the match is covered
