## **Executive Board Review:**

Steve- Treasury: \$374, 316. Almost all bills have been paid other than permits. In the process of reconciling statements with National. Reimbursements: if anything needs to be reimbursed over \$200, let Steve and Bill know prior to purchase so they have the information, and ideally within the 30 day window for any reimbursement.

Ofir- Coaching: Need follow up discussion with 8U coaches as well as discussion of field monitoring. Players heading the ball and slide tackling, not developmentally appropriate. All-stars discussion of scheduling for 60 vs. 90 minute practices. Lay out the expectation ahead of time.

Kim- Reminder that coaches need to make sure they are clear into post season play with safesport/background checks. Our insurance will not cover if a team is not activated, team not activated without coach certifications, therefore, they would not be able to practice.

Jeb- Preliminary schedule discussion for end of season play.

Corinne- Post Fall core programs: Winter player development (M, T, Th). Also: Thanksgiving, Winter and Spring camps. Hand-out of postcards works well, should use again in the Spring.

## **Simplification of Schedule**

Discussion on pre-determined practice times for each age level to help keep people from dropping, switching, or from teams practicing 90 min 1x/week as opposed to 60 min 2/week. 2x/week for 8-10 seems like too much of a commitment. Can coaches offer skills clinics for those who want more? Think about more efficiency in what we are offering people. Practice 1x/week for 90 min, offer M-Th, with Friday for skills.

## **Engagement**

Adult pick-up to generate more volunteers, coaches- sign up for 1x/week during off times of kids practices, online through AYSO adult program.

Go back in database to post all-star kids for engagement.
