- **1. RC Updates – Alex**

- **Approved last meeting minutes**

- New Complex – We do not know yet what is going to be the cost. It is currently set at \$95. That does not include the lights. At Del Aire yearly including the lights and porta potties was just \$74,620. We are done paying for Del Aire field for now. With \$24,340 of that being spent only on lights last year. About \$30,000 for lights and porta potty. Lisa is working with the school now and we can see if they can give us credit with the lights. The High School and now Flag Football, Cheer and Softball are all using the field and we are being charged for the lights. Region 7 is being charged about \$125-150 an hour for their fields but to counter that they charge more for the players. The school board isn't in it for the money; the money is truly for the maintenance. Obviously, it is high school first, AYSO/Little League come second. We should look at what baseball and softball are going to be charged, and it should be a

jump off base for us. Start at \$25,000-30,000 but no more than what we were paying at Del Aire. The money is there for Del Aire to be replaced but it is not in bad shape. If we get a good deal at the new Aviation field, we will be able to play on Saturday and Sunday. We need to get a group of our parents together to represent AYSO and go talk to the district. We could negotiate a flat fee yearly vs hourly. There are factors that change such as energy prices, daylight savings, players per season. Measure E costs Wiseburn Families \$30/\$100,000 of assessed property value annually. Alex needs to decide who is part of the conversation and meeting with the WUSD Board. We should move to push for a meeting at the end of February. Once Alex chooses a group then they will decide when to meet with the WUSD. The team will meet informally before the meeting to decide on the approach. We don't want to go in with a number we want to go in to discuss how it impacts on our families and our region. Chevy will let Mario know what numbers he needs. We should not turn over paperwork with our numbers to them. We need a guarantee of usage with our payment. We pay annually for Del Aire but consistently lose field space to other entities.

- Area – Wild Card for GU12 so it went to Hector Garses.
- Tournament Teams – Jesse is out sick but wanted to talk about this with the group. There needs to be a cap of how many they can go to. Required tournaments are Downey, Mission Viejo, and Founders Cup are all mandatory and can go to two more. Spring ends first week of June.
- Winterfest – going smooth and players are growing and developing well.

- Facilitron – They cancelled reservations, but they are do not send a notification. They prefer we do it seasonally not annually. Lisa is inputting and monitoring the calendar.
- **2. Registrar- Susie**
  - Spring Registration is open will close February 21<sup>st</sup> so we can create the teams. We can play in house if we have enough players or we will have to play Area play for U8 and above. Preference is to play Area. We cap every division and those who go on the waitlist we wait to see if we can get enough for another team. They will send lists to the commissioners so they can see who is playing and who will be coaching.
