• 1. RC Updates – Alex

- Approved last meeting minutes

 missed. He took the extra coach & player picture which was a surprise
 to everyone. Thank you so much to all of our volunteers.
- o Instead of doing the chocolates should we raise the price \$25-30 a player? We raise between \$10-20,000. If we raise the price then the money is only for the kids not for the regions needs.
- The prices will be going up on the chocolate.
- Other regions have higher sign up charge so they do not have to sell chocolates.
- Alex will talk to the other RCs to see how they pay for the things they need outside of players needs.

- Area Meeting- doing great, no complaints. Red Cards Hawthorne vs
 Hawthorne. One was for profanity towards the ref in El Segundo.
- Area 1 D is setting the standard for the RAP. It is new so bear with them
 as they find the path. So far it is working.
 - If you do a U16/19 you need the sheets and game cards.
 - They will have 2 more referee classes for intermediate and advanced towards the end of the month. Alex to send dates to Hemant so he can put on the website.
 - A descent or a Yellow Card does not mean you have to do a RAP report. If you have several it does require one.

• 5. Coach Administrators Update – Jesse

- Need to be cleaning up the trash at the fields. There is no one designated to take out the trash so if you see it handle it.
- AllStars meeting 10/15/2025 for the commissioners only. Once ratings sheets are turned in same day. Quick review of rating sheets, how we will move forward and make selections and so on.
- U8 needs to do ratings sheets but does not have to turn them in until the end of the season. They will not get their medals until they turn one in.
- All U10 & U12 teams need to be certified and have a certified referee on their team or they cannot enter into playoffs.
- Epic will be using the field at Hollyglen 10/18 until 12/12:30. All games before that need to be rescheduled. We can push them later Saturday and/or Sunday. Alex will have Murl look at the schedule and adjust the dates.

• 6. Referee Administrator Update- Esteban

- If there is enough abuse to the referee in any division, any person can report this incident to the RAP program. When you feel there was an injustice to the referee.
- Whenever there was a referee involved in an incident, it needs to go to AREA.
- It does go through Esteban first who needs to verify it rises to the level of necessity to go to AREA.
- Coach Mike Hiney cannot coach his U12 game this weekend per the
 AREA decision. He was remorseful and showed it within the hour.

 Esteban will have a conversation with Coach Hiney regarding his
 behavior and how we move forward. A licensed coach of that same
 division must run their games and or practices. The RC will let him know.
- The AYSO Guidelines in the Yellow book state that all volunteer duties/activities are not to be allowed for the time they are to serve out their suspension.
- Esteban went up and asked for more clarification and to see who hands out the decision. He can show grace or hand out the full sentence. We need to be consistent though.
- We need to decide as a region, do we just give one suspension for the one game for the U12 or do we suspend our volunteers from all volunteer roles for a week. This includes practices, games for all teams.
 We decided as a board, that it is for just that division for which the action was done.

- First Youth Referee class was held last week. We have 5 new youth referees. Madison Mialaret has completed her test. If they referee games a board member will be on the field with them. There is ZERO tolerance.
- No one showed up to the Referee class this past weekend. MANDATORY RULE: if there are no ARs then the coaches need to get an AR from their team. Otherwise, the game will be called a tie and they can play a scrimmage. We need all teams to submit one referee. They will do the online portion, then reach out to Esteban and/or Jorge and do a 2-hour field portion with one of them. We need more referees because we are not getting enough support.
