 - 2 or 3 Boys 10U Premier or 1 Premier and 1 Select or 2 Premier and 1 Select
 - 2 Girls 10 U 1 Premier and 1 Select

- Village:

- Advanced Intermediate Coaching Roadshow

- Division Commissioner Issues:
 - Boys 10U
 - Coach Hiney Team 4 (away team) vs Coach Hernandez Team 11 (home)
 - Home team did not prepare a center ref
 - Angelica Hiney volunteered to be center ref
 - Parent from home team stated center ref made a “bad” call
 - Parent continued on, was warned by center ref if this continued the game would be called off
 - Parent continued, game was called off
 - Norma (commissioner for boys U10) did go and speak with Team 11 and advised that we protect our coaches and refs
 - Hiney’s had to be walked to their car due to Team 11 families behavior
 - Need to consider suspending parent
 - Due to the issues with Boys 10U and Boys 8U the past weekend, Alex will be walking the fields starting the weekend of 11/18&19 (out of town this weekend 11/11&12)
- CVPA
 - Julie Guthrie and Eddie Rivas need to go over process of CVPA re: Coaches and Parents Suspensions
 - Needs to be odd number 3/5/7
 - Last person to ask is Alex Guerrero to be part of the panel
- Commissioners need to turn in extra uniforms to Susie ASAP
- Soccerfest:
 - Soccerfest will go live this week
 - Signups close the 12/14th
 - \$50 for returning players/\$80 for new players
 - 8 weekends of games 1/6 to the 24/28th
 - Then we will open up spring
 - Alex will run Soccerfest
 - 14Us and up will go onto an auto waitlist until we see how many players register then it will open
 - Gerard 14U girls training w/futsal scrimmages after: what day and time?
- Need to bring back parent meeting BEFORE start of season
- Consideration for adding Junior Skills Training for 8U-14U
 - Would need pinnies for scrimmages after skills training
 - 9-10 am skills clinic for 8U&10U
 - Follow with a 20 minute scrimmage
 - 10:45-12 pm skills clinic for 12U&14U
 - Follow with 30 minute scrimmage
 - If you pay for soccerfest you can attend for free
 - Who runs this?

- Who creates the plan?
- Spring Season
 - Starts March 9 to May 19th or possibly June
 - Early bird registration will be \$80 through all of December
 - Beginning January it will jump to \$100
 - This is very low for the area when local regions are \$140/\$175
- Referees:
 - Major issues as the referees are not going above
 - They stay for the one game and leave instead of checking if the next game is covered
 - Need to assist
 - State of ref is in bad shape
 - Create an app for refs
 - For playoffs no ref will be allowed to do it unless they are authorized by Jorge
 - This will become the model for the spring for 10U/12U/14U
 - Jorge will share a list of referees
 - Jorge will set up ref class
 - Jorge will visit the refs who took the classes and have done nothing since in order to follow up
 - Ref hats
 - We need to take care of those who show up and do the work/put in the time and effort
 - Advanced certified referees and coaches will get a jacket
- 8U and below will all get medals
- Need to discuss before next board meeting:
 - Victor and 19U- keep for spring and fall or suspend as his behavior has gotten worse. This is a board decision. Need to know the pros and cons. Due process.
