- 1) www.AYSO21.org (Region 21 website, register to sign up your kids, parents can register to volunteer, check your certifications you have).

- 2) www.aysoU.org has all the online coach/referee courses and class locations. Access is inside the AYSO21.org website. To get access, login, click on Volunteer tab on left side of screen, when done, click on risk status, this will begin the background check process. An email will be sent. Once this process is completed, you will now see the AYSO button appear inside your AYSO volunteer page on right side. Once approved you will have access to coaching/refereeing courses.
- 3) Safe haven course, cdc concussion course, Safesport , cardiac arrest.

COACH CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS AND TIMELINE:

Required every year: All Coaches in all divisions and all Referees must sign volunteer form via **ONLINE**. All coaches must take safe haven and cdc concussion online class prior to start of season.

	U5 – U7 coach
1 st yr	U8 coach, online course
2 nd yr	U8 coach should consider taking U10 coaching class and or regional referee class before season or before fall season.
1 st yr	U10 coach must have U10 coach certification by end of season. Take online coach course + Field portion. Highly recommended to take regional referee class too.
2 nd yr	U10 coach should consider taking Intermediate coaching class in preparation for next season.
1 st yr	U12 coach should take the 12u online course + field portion and or take take the regional referee class.
2 nd yr	U12 coach should consider taking intermediate coach certification in preparation for next year.
1 st yr	U14 coach must have Intermediate coach certification by end of year and consider taking regional referee class.
2 nd yr	U14 coach should consider taking Advanced coach class to prepare for upper divisions.
	U16/U19 Must have Advanced Coach Certification.
