# What?! No heading?

The days of younger kids heading the ball in a soccer game or practice are over. After a class-action lawsuit in a U.S. District Court in California to several organizations, a ruling was reached that works to prevent head injuries. In compliance with the new guideline AYSO will enforce 'No Heading' policy for U12 and under.

In adherence to these new requirements, *When a player **deliberately** heads the ball in a game, an indirect free kick should be awarded to the opposing team from the spot of the offense. If the **deliberate** header occurs within the goal area, the indirect free kick should be taken on the goal area line parallel to the goal line at the point nearest to where the infringement occurred.*

Some experts claim the ban on heading could result in more talented players in the coming years because they are forced to become more skilled with their feet.

Please be patient as we implement this new policy and propagate to Coaches, Referees, Players and Parents. AYSO strive to provide Youth Soccer in a Safe, Fair, and Fun Environment.

Just a Reminder, Referees are critical to the game of soccer - without them the game cannot be played! AYSO Referees are all volunteers, just like the coaches, administrators, field workers, and everyone else who make AYSO work. Most referees are parents or relatives of the players, and some youth referees are even players themselves. Referees range in experience from beginner to very experienced, and all referees are offered plenty of opportunities for training within our region. Volunteers generally referee between one game every other week to several games each Saturday. Thank you for your support!
