# Referee Pre, Half and Post Game Duties and Activities

# **Pre-Game**

- Arrive early
  - At least 15 minutes prior to game time (20-30 minutes if first game of the day)
  - In proper uniform
  - With required equipment:

Watch, pens, whistle, coin, flags, data wallet

# Check field and equipment

- Markings
- Holes, glass, rocks, debris, etc.
- Goals (properly secured) and placed
- Nets (secured, no holes/gaps)
- Corner flags
- Ball(s) (Home team provides)

# • Introduce yourself to the Coach & Assistant Coach

- Learn their names and write them down
- Be approachable (not flippant, cold or arrogant)
- Request Lineup Cards (aka Game Cards)

## Check players equipment

- Team Uniform:
- Shirt, Shorts, Shoes, Socks, Shinguards
  - If both teams have same color jerseys Home team changes color or wears pennies
- If thermal shorts are worn, they must be the same color as the shorts
- Shin guards must be under the socks
- Goalkeeper's shirt must be distinguishable (different color/or pattern)

#### Nothing dangerous (in your opinion)

- No jewelry, watches, earrings
- No casts or splints (even if padded)
- Hard knee braces are okay, but only if padded and safe to all players (in your opinion)
- Medical alert bracelets may be worn, but must be secured to the player with tape, cloth wristband or something similar that is safe. **The information must remain visible**.

#### Brief Assistant Referees

- Neutral AR's:
- Work as a team
- Follow standard signals
- Discuss non-standard signals

#### • Club Linesperson: Non-neutral

- Explain expectations
- Put at ease
- Only call ball out of play (wholly, explain)
- Raise flag straight up when ball has gone completely over the line.

## Conduct coin toss

- Home team calls
- Winning team choose direction of attack (goal to defend for younger players)
- · Losing team kicks off

#### Half-time

- Collect game ball(s)
- Verify scores
- Verify substitutions
- List score for your team's line-up card first
- Discuss any issues and feedback during half

# Post-game

- Collect the game gall(s) and return to owner
- Supervise team handshake
- Complete Lineup Cards
  - Verify substitutions
  - Verify scores
  - Print name (legibly) first and last name
  - Sign name at bottom if Misconduct Report necessary
  - Deposit in proper division box at referee station
- Congratulate referee team and seek feedback
