

DISCRIMINATION, ABUSE & VOLUNTEER COMPLIANCE POLICIES

Region 58 adheres to and enforces federal and California laws, and AYSO's policies, against discrimination, harassment, abuse or violence. AYSO prohibits, and is obligated to report, all forms of child abuse, including emotional, physical, sexual, ethical abuse and neglect. Any incidents in violation of these policies, if observed, should be reported to the Region's CVPA, Regional Commissioner, or a Regional Board Member.

All Board Members and all volunteers with regular close contact with children, including coaches and referees, must submit a background check and fingerprints, and pass certain training courses required by law, in addition to other training courses required by AYSO. Please consult an AYSO Board member or ayso58.org for current requirements. Please save all certificates showing courses passed.

All coaches and referees must have complied with the background check and fingerprint requirements prior to their first practice, and all other training requirements prior to the first match, absent written permission from the Regional Commissioner, Regional Coach Administrator, Regional Referee Administrator, or Applicable Division Coordinator and an approved plan for completion of these requirements.

Region 58 reserves all rights to remove volunteers who do not meet these requirements or who violate these policies.
