## 12 Rules for Region 58 Referees

1. ACT LIKE A PROFESSIONAL REFEREE

(Keep the game safe, fair and fun. Be respectful of players, coaches and parents)

2. LOOK LIKE A PROFESSIONAL REFEREE

(Ref jersey, ref shorts, ref socks, and chronograph wristwatch)

- 3. DO NOT SIGN UP TO CENTER REFEREE IN YOUR CHILD'S DIVISION (Ok to A/R or cross-over to opposite division)
- 4. DO NOT SIGN UP TO REFEREE YOUR CHILD'S GAME

(Ok, if you are drafted at game time, with consent of opposing Coach and you work in full Referee uniform, you will get a Ref Point)

5. DO NOT SIGN UP FOR GAMES ABOVE YOUR BADGE LEVEL

(Region up to 10U, Intermediate up to 12U, Advanced up to 14U, for exceptions contact Ref Staff)

6. THE CGI SIGN UP PROGRAM CLOSES AT 5PM FRIDAY

(If you didn't sign up by 5pm, you will not be on Saturday's schedule)

- 7. DO NOT SIGN UP FOR 8U MATCHES UNTIL ALL 10U MATCHES ARE FILLED
- 8. DO NOT USE CGI TO SIGN UP TO CENTER REFEREE MORE THAN TWO BOYS MATCHES ON ANY SATURDAY

(Ok to sign up for any openings on Saturday morning at the referee tent at the park)

- 9. CHECK IN AT THE REFEREE TENT AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR MATCH (Meet your crew and have a pre-game meeting. If you can't make the game, contact our ref scheduler ASAP)
- 10. BOTH GAME CARDS MUST BE FULLY AND ACCURATELY FILLED OUT (PRINT referee names and team numbers)
- 11. DO NOT SHOW YELLOW OR RED CARDS TO 10U PLAYERS OR SUBSTITUTES. (Be a teacher not a policeman)
- 12. WHEN SIGNING UP FOR MATCHES AVOID ANY APPEARANCE OF IMPROPRIETY.

(For example, signing up in advance to referee games of the same coach for the entire season could have the appearance of impropriety. The Region 58 Referee Administrator has the authority to reassign games in these situations.)
