## AYSO Screenland Classic XXIII Team Invitation



Scope:	AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams from all Sections.
When:	Saturday & Sunday, March 21 & 22, 2026 - <b>Boys &amp; Girls 10U-19U</b>
Where:	The tournament will be held at Culver City High School and local Culver City Parks. <b>No animals of any kind are allowed</b> at any of the tournament venues.
Who:	AYSO boys' and girls' teams in age divisions: 19U & 16U (11v11) 18 players max; 14U (11v11) 15 players max; 12U (9v9) 12 players max; 10U (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered and have played in the AYSO 2025 primary season. Guest players will be allowed (2 maximum per team). No Co-Ed teams. AYSO e4 Affinity roster required.
What:	Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed 3 games in pool play. All pool play games and semi-finals (if played) will be as follows: 64 min for 19U-16U, 44 min. for 14U, 12U, and 10U All final games (if played) will be AYSO regulation time.
Why:	Screenland Classic is being conducted as a fundraiser by Region 19 to raise funds for Field Development, Equipment, & Maintenance, and to provide Scholarship funds for youths in Region 19 and the surrounding community.
Awards:	All players and 2 coaches per team will receive a tournament souvenir. All players, 10U-19U, on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> , & 4 <sup>th</sup> place teams will receive a medal if more than 5 teams in a pool. All players, 10U-19U, on the 1 <sup>st</sup> place teams will receive a trophy.
Entry Fee, Refunds:	\$550 for 10U, \$575 for 12U, \$600 for 14U, \$650 for 16U, &19U. A full refund will be issued if the tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found.
Referee Fee, Refunds:	\$300 referee deposit for 10U-19U, refundable within 14 days of the tournament if referee assignments have been completed. Priority will be given to those teams that provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament. Please be aware that if you are not qualified to referee upper division games, you will be expected to referee lower division games.
Rules: Acceptance:	A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website. The application deadline is <b>February 20, 2026</b> . All teams will be notified within 72 hrs. of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application & fees returned within 48 hours or to be placed on a waiting list.
How:	Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, <b>along with</b> the tournament application, referee information form, and team roster to the Tournament Registrar address below. The Regional commissioner must sign the application and roster. RRA or ARA must sign referee information form for all divisions.
