	Board members noted that high school and club soccer play are resuming this week.	increase at a future meeting.
	Discussion re: contacting city council to make soccer a priority for use of fields and facilities.	
	Suggestion is made by Regional Safety Director (RSD) to increase registration fees slightly to accommodate PPE and other Covid-related items.	
	MOTION (by R. Chen, second by M. Peek) to: Increase registration fees by an amount necessary to safely operate a soccer season, taking into account additional costs for PPE, safety and disinfection equipment, instant-read thermometers, AED machines, etc. Discussion of amount of increase is had. Board voted on Motion, and Motion was unanimously approved, in concept. Board did not set an amount of fee increase, pending research by the RSD about the costs of these safety materials.	

Traci Wargo- Lehman	Donation to AYSO National:  Large regions, such as R254, are being asked to donate \$2,000 to AYSO National.  RC informed the Board that a \$2,500 donation was made to AYSO National on behalf of R254.  Suggestion is made by ARC Meade to increase donation if our registrations are lower than last year.	None.
Traci Wargo- Lehman	Marketing Fall 2021:  RC is recommending outreach to preschool players to interest them in soccer.  Member Peek – this is an Olympic soccer year. Recommends marketing to all ages with a focus on the USA Women's Olympic team.  Member Grigorian – recommends flier distribution to local preschools to market soccer.  Member Mullins – inquired about marketing budget. RC will meet with Area Director (AD) to discuss formation of the Region's budget.	None at Regional level.  RC to determine marketing budget after consultation with AD.
Traci Wargo- Lehman	Assessment of Players Upon Return to Soccer:  If we are doing camps, this doesn't matter. If we are hosting games, this will be necessary.	None.

Area is scheduling a Fall season on the assumption that games will be played. Therefore, we need to be prepared to do player assessments before a season can begin.

Member Elkin – Kids are still in the same boat. Ratings are likely to be the same. Create an objective set of criteria to assess players.

Regional Coach Administrator – Need to reevaluate players since it will be two years since players have played.

Member Yamarone – Region should utilize assessments from 2019 "with an asterisk."

Member Badalian-Collins – Asked about which divisions an assessment would apply to. She is informed that it would apply to Age Divisions 10U and Above. Has concerns about unbalanced teams. Region should reserve the right to redistribute players during the season.

Member Elkin – Recommends a meeting with the coaches at the end of the season and review the ratings among them to determine accuracy and accord.

Member Badalian-Collins – Emphasized a need to identify high-ranking players in each Age Division.
