
### AYSO's Vision Statement






# SUPPORT THE KIDS ZONE

- Celebrate the Player Win or Lose!








# CO-ED US DIVISION

- Non-Competitive Divsion
- No score will be kept
- 6 players on a roster
- 4 v 4 on the field
- 2 full 15 minute halves will be played which includes quarter breaks
- Players will be substituted during quarter breaks
- No Goal Keepers
- Throw ins are now pass in by the foot on the touch line
- The coach is the referee/ each coach will ref half the game
- Games will be played on Saturday
- Practice 1x week for an hour, no later than 6:30pm
- Size 3 Soccer Ball will be needed
- Shin guards are required
- Cleats preferred but can wear tennis shoes
- No earrings/jewelry






# Boys & Girls U8 Division

- Non-Competitive Divsion
- No score will be kept
- 9 players on a roster
- 7 v 7 on the field this includes the goalie
- 3 Certified Referees required for each team
- Two full 20 minutes halves played which includes quarter breaks
- All players must play 1/2 the game
- Goal Keepers can only play 2 quarters in the goal
- Build-out line introduced in U8
- No offsides in U8
- No punts/No headers
- Coaches are NOT allowed on the field
- Practice can be held 2x a week for an hour, no later than 7:30pm
- Cleats are recommended
- Shin Guards are Required
- Size 3 Soccer Ball






# Boys & Girls U10

- This is a Competitive Divsion
- Score will be kept
- 10 players on a roster
- 7 v 7 on the field
- All players must play at least 1/2 the game
- Goal Keepers can play 2 quarters in the goal
- 3 Certified Referees Required for all teams
- Offside Rules is now in effect!
- Build-out line is the staple of U10
- Two 25 minute halves which includes quarter breaks
- No punts/ No Headers
- Games will be played on Saturday
- Practice 2x week for an hour no later than 7:30pm
- Size 4 Soccer Ball
- Shin guards are required
- Cleats preferred






# **Build Out Line**


The purpose of the build out line is to teach players how to advance the ball out of the back by keeping the ball in possession, now becoming the attacking team. This will facilitate player development by allowing the attacking team the opportunity to receive and play the ball in a controlled method rather than the chaotic, more common method of punting the ball up the field and the ensuing scramble for possession (which is usually lost to the opposing team 80% of the time). In addition, players learn to control the ball, have less opportunity to head the ball, and reduce the dangerous play of high kicking because the ball remains on the ground.

# Build Out Line & Offside

The build-out line shall be used as the line to determine offside. Players cannot be penalized for an offside offense between the halfway line and the build-out line.








# Boys & Girls U12

- This is a Competitive Divsion
- Score will be kept
- 12 players on a roster
- 9 v 9 on the field
- All players must play at least 1/2 the game
- Goal Keepers can play up to 3 quarters in goal and 1 quarter on the field.
- 2 (30) minute halves will be played
- Substitutions will be done at quarter breaks
- 3 Certified Referees are required for all teams
- NO HEADERS
- Games will be played on Saturday
- Practice 2x week for an hour no later than 8:00pm
- Size 4 Soccer Ball
- Shin guards are required
- Cleats preferred
- No earrings/jewelry





- 11 v 11
- Size 5 Soccer Ball
- U14 games will be played in Area Circuit
- U16 games will be played in Section Circuit
- Headers are allowed in these divisions
- U14 substitutions at quarters
- U16 Free substitutions
- 3 Certified Referees Required for all teams
- Shin Guards are Required
- Cleats are recommended
- No earrings or jewelry
- Practices 2x week for 1 hour and a half





# EXTRA PROGRAM


### **AYSO EXTRA is a Progressive Player Program**

First Touch Trainers will provide our AYSO 54 Coaches with clinics throughout the season.


Each week First Touch will host clinics which coaches and their teams can attend.









# HEJA Team App

Players are **required** to wear shin guards underneath socks.


Cleats not required but highly recommended

# Not Allowed

- No jewelry (Earrings, watches, necklaces) & No Hats (i.e. baseball hats)
- Medical alert bracelets are the only exception
- No sunglasses are allowed unless they are prescription sunglasses
- No casts or splints even if they're padded and the player has been cleared by a doctor








# Cerritos Sun Kissed Cup

# Rain Policy

Region 54 <u>does not</u> cancel games due to rain. However, The City of Cerritos might. If games get cancelled, coaches will notify you. We will also update our website, social media page, and send out an email alert through Sports Connect.

Note: If there's thunder & lightning, play is stopped immediately and everyone should leave the field to a safe area (typically a car). Play cannot resume until 30 minutes after all thunder & lightning have stopped.

# **Heat Policy**


If the day is deemed hot, all games will be given an extra water break per quarter. Please make sure to bring plenty of water during these days.

The Region will put out a notice if there will be any cancellations. Your coach will notify you first.

### **Game Cancellations**

Cancelled games will not be re-scheduled. If make-up dates become available, parents will be notified.






# REGION 54 SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Non-Registered Players/Volunteers <u>cannot</u> participate in practices or games (siblings <u>cannot</u> help during practices)
- Under <u>no circumstances</u> should adults play in scrimmages/games with players That inlcudes playing games with other adults or minors.

- Please feel free to discuss any concerns with your coaches & the Region. (i.e. Learning disabilities, the Region will work with you)


















# Respect the Volunteers

### **CDC Concussion Awareness**

Volunteers will be given insight on the telltale signs of a concussion and know what to do in case one appears to occur.

### **Sudden Cardiac Arrest Course**

Volunteers are provided information to help recognize the signs and risk factors for SCA

### Safe Sport Course

Volunteers are provided information to help recognize adult/minor misconduct awareness and abuse prevention


### Coach/ Asst. Coach Certifications

Volunteers are required to complete Regional Referee traiing to become certified as a Referee in AYSO.



### Opening Tasks - First game of the day


- Place goals on field/add nets to goals

- Pick up any trash around the field








# We Always Need Referees!


- A game cannot be played unless there is a certified referee assigned to the game.
- The Referee is responsible for enforcing the Laws of the Game in such a way as to keep the game Safe, Fair & Fun.
- A referee's authority extends to everyone at the field, including players, substitues, team officials, spectators, and assistnat referees.
- The referee is expected to interfere with the game as little as possible, avoiding making calls for doubtful and trifling offenses.
- Refereeing is AYSO is a challening and rewarding volunteer experience. Here is an opportunity for you to join the kids on the pitch as they learn to love the "Beautiful Game."



# **Youth Referees**

- Referees officiate U8 division matches. They will control the flow and enforce the rules.
- While the Laws of the Game will be enforced, the goal is to help keep the match flowing and allow the kids to have fun!
- Youth Referees are actively involved in refereeing games in our U8 & U10 divisions.
- We have a **ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY** on negative comments or verbal abuse of our youth volunteers. We will stop the game and ask you to leave! No Exceptions, No Excuses!
- Abuse of any sort toward the referee will NOT be tolerated.



Uniforms will be distributed to parents by coaches within the next few weeks.


