
### RESPECT THE VOLUNTEERS

## REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS

#### SAFE HAVEN COURSE

The course covers all of AYSO's philosophies on promoting safety, injury prevention as well as behaviors necessary to create a positive soccer experience.

## CDC CONCUSSION COURSE

Volunteers will be given insight on the telltale signs of a concussion and know what to do in case one appears to occur.

#### **SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST**

Volunteers are provided to help recognize the signs and risk factors for SCA.



#### **SAFE SPORT COURSE**

Volunteers are provided to help recognizing adult/minor misconduct awareness and abuse prevention

### LIVE SCAN CERTIFICATION

Fingerprinting technology that scans for criminal history background checks



### COACH / ASST. COACH CERTIFICATIONS




#### **VOLUNTEER POINTS**

In order to qualify for the **Gem of the Valley Cup**, teams will need to earn Volunteer Points throughout the season. Teams can earn volunteer points in several different ways.

Tent Duty | Field Lining | Photographer |
Coach Certs | Refereeing | Referee Certs |
Goal Set-up | Become a Certified Team Parent

All teams that meet the minimum requirements for Volunteer Points will be eligible to participate in the **Gem of the Valley Cup**. Seeding for the cup will be based on win/loss record, with total number of volunteer points being the tie-breaker if teams end up with the same record.

















  Each division has its own requirements

- Sportsmanship Points: Referee(s) will assess each match Each division has its own requirements
- Pictures Points: E-Mail Weekly(4 action shots + Pin Winner weekly)
- Player Evaluations: Due by week 7 of season






#### THE REFEREE'S ROLE

- We are all Volunteers. We will make mistakes during a game. Please work with us to make the game positive for the players.


















## REFERES ARE ALWAYS NEEDED









## YOUTH REFEREES

- Our Region has a ZERO Tolerance for dissent or abuse of a Youth Referee.


























In pictures A and C, the hair beads worn by each player are not securely fasten to the head In pictures B and D, the hair beads worn are securely fastened to the head









In picture A, the player cannot play with the hair adornment in the current position as it is not securely fastened to the head. Players in pictures B and C are allowed.



In pictures A, B, C & D the hair control devices are worn securely fastened and are allowed. In picture E, the hair device is not allowed as it is not securely fastened to the head.





With referee abuse on the rise for youth and amateur matches, it's time to take a stand.


Referees are essential to soccer, but far too often risk their emotional and physical well-being in service to the game.


#### PHYSICAL OFFENSES of gross misconduct, abuse, and / or assault

PHYSICAL*	MIN. GAMES	TIME
Minor or Slight Deliberate Touching	3	1 - 6 Months
Pushing, Grabbing, Pulling, Squeezing, Pinching, Lightly Slapping, Use of Object in Non Striking Manner, or Physical Property Damage	10	6 - 24 Months
Hitting, Punching, Elbowing, Kicking, Biting, Spiting, Choking, Tackling, Throwing or Use of Object or Any Part of Body (Forearm, Knee, Head) in a Striking Manner		12 Months - Lifetime

#### **KEY PENALTY FACTORS**

- Single offenses are at minimum the prescribed game penalty or time penalty for non red zone offenses
- Penalties can be both game and time depending on severity / circumstances
- Second time offenders receive double punishment
- Third time offenders receive a lifetime ban
- More than one offense at the same time is at least the punishment for the most serious offense
- Offenses against minors are automatically subject to a "minor multiplier" resulting in triple punishment
- One offense warning per league to be managed by states and leagues collaboratively
- Game consequences are inclusive of 1 game penalty for any red cards given
- Optionality for 50% penalty for first offense from a minor






#### **RAIN POLICY**

AYSO 1463 **does not** cancel games due to the rain. However, the City of Murrieta might. If games get canceled, Coaches will notify you. We will also update our Social Media pages and send out an email alert through Sports Connect.

**Note:** If there's thunder and lightning, play is stopped immediately and everyone should leave the field to a safe area (typically a car). Play cannot resume until 30 minutes after all thunder and lightning have stopped.


#### **HEAT POLICY**

If the day is deemed hot, all games will be given an extra water break per quarter. Please make sure to bring LOTS of water during these days.



# SAFETY NOTES TO KEEP IN MIND

- Non-Registered Players / Volunteers <u>cannot</u> participate in practices or Games (siblings cannot help during practices)
- Under no circumstances should adults play in Scrimmages/Games.
   That includes playing games with other adults or minor (this does indeed include Coaches)
- Club Linesman/person Not Covered by Insurance
- Parents must remain on field with Children (10U & Under)
   No drop-offs during practice
- Be sure to discuss concerns with your parents & the Region
   I.e. Learning Disabilities | The Region will work with you!
- No clear identification of Players! Clothing, backpacks, etc. must avoid displaying player names for safety reasons. Regarding **team banners**, names are OK as long as it's a first name only and it doesn't tie the name to a specific jersey number.













## SAFETY NOTES TO KEEP IN MIND




#### **ALWAYS REMEMBER!**

- Physical contact with players is NOT ALLOWED!
  - Back rubs
  - Shoulder rubs
  - Hugs, etc.
  - This includes grabbing their arms to move them around the field, for example
- This can open us up to possible Safe Sport related violations!







## **EQUIPMENT LIST FOR PLAYERS**

AYSO 1463 provides uniforms which include a Jersey, Shorts and Socks.

Players are required to wear shin guards underneath their socks


Cleats not required but highly recommended

- 8U & Below: Size 3 ball
- 10U-12U: Size 4 ball
- 14U and above: Size 5 ball
- Captain Armbands: Two bands per team provided (Captain Armbands Required for 10U & Above)
- Water! Please bring lots of water!

# PARTITION OF THE PARTIT

#### **NOT ALLOWED**

- No jewelry (Earrings, Watches, Necklaces)
- Medical alert bracelets are the only exception (the bracelet must be taped down)
- No sunglasses are allowed unless they are prescription sunglasses
- · No casts or splints even if they're padded and the player has been cleared by a doctor
- Soft braces are ok No metal inserts
- No Hats with Hard Bills (no Baseball Hats) / Knit Caps OK for younger players on cold days
- No Radios/Speakers, No Noise Makers (Parents)




## **GEM OF THE VALLEY CUP!**
