



EXTRA Referee Cheat Sheet

The following information includes the Key Responsibilities for referees assigned to EXTRA games.

Before the Game

- Arrive 30 minutes before game time, check the field for safety, etc.
- Team Check-In
 - Check Player ID Cards against game cards
 - ID Cards are **KEPT BY THE COACHES**
- Coaches and Assistants need to be wearing their coach IDs

Age-Specific Notable Items

• 9U/10U

On goal kicks, defending players **are not** permitted cross the build-out line **until the ball is in play** (i.e., Kicked and clearly moves); ball may be kicked over the build-out line intentionally

Goal keepers **are** permitted distribute the ball anywhere on the field (i.e., they can throw it past the build-out line

- Once a goalkeeper puts the ball on the ground (other than a goal kick), the opposing team may make a play for the ball (i.e., they do not have to retreat behind the build-out line)
- 11U/12U
 - No heading

The Game

- Record Yellow and Red Cards, and scores accurately
- If a Coach or Assistant Coach is sent off, the game is terminated and becomes a forfeit for that team
 - Coaches are responsible for parents on their touchline

Post-Game

- Supervise handshakes between teams
- Both Coaches will take pictures of the game cards and e-mail them to scores.extra.west@gmail.com or scores.extra.east@gmail.com
- Physical Game cards will be taken by the Home Team or Coordinator
- Red card reports made on the referee page of the EXTRA website at aysosection1EXTRA.org
