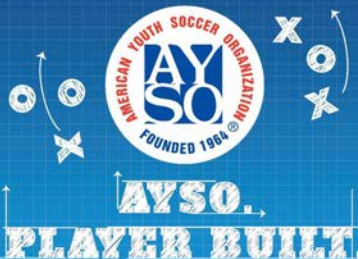

## REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS

### SAFE HAVEN COURSE

The course covers all of AYSO's philosophies on promoting safety, injury prevention as well as behaviors necessary to create a positive soccer experience.

### CDC CONCUSSION COURSE

Volunteers will be given insight on the telltale signs of a concussion and know what to do in case one appears to occur.

### SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST

Volunteers are provided to help recognize the signs and risk factors for SCA.



### SAFE SPORT COURSE

Volunteers are provided to help recognizing adult/minor misconduct awareness and abuse prevention

### LIVE SCAN CERTIFICATION

Fingerprinting technology that scans for criminal history background checks



### COACH / ASST. COACH CERTIFICATIONS

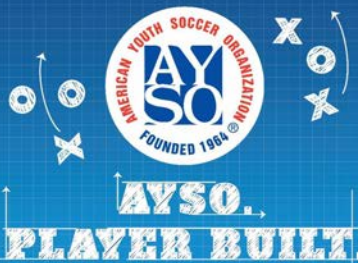
Coaches are required to complete certification up to the division they are coaching. Certs for older divisions require in-person training.

Volunteers are required to complete Regional Referee training to become certified as a Referee in AYSO.





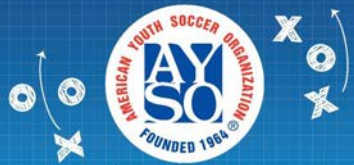

# VOLUNTEER POINTS PROGRAM

- In order to qualify for the **Gem of the Valley** Cup, teams will need to earn Volunteer Points throughout the season. Teams can earn volunteer points in several different ways.

Tent Duty | Field Lining | Photographer |  
Coach Certs | Refereeing | Referee Certs |  
Goal Set-up | Become a Certified Team Parent

- All teams that meet the minimum requirements for Volunteer Points will be eligible to participate in the Gem of the Valley Cup. Seeding for the cup will be based on win/loss record, with total number of volunteer points being the tie-breaker if teams end up with the same record.

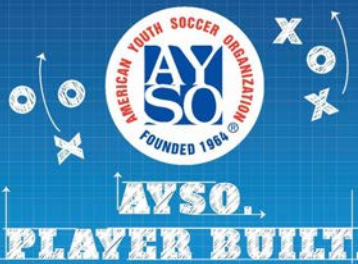

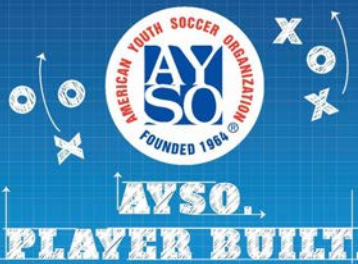


## THE REFEREE'S ROLE

- The Referee is responsible for enforcing the Laws of the Game while keeping the game **Safe, Fair, & Fun!**
- In divisions 8U and above, without a certified referee to officiate the game, the game cannot be played
- **No Certified Referee = No Game Played**
- We are all Volunteers. We will make mistakes during a game. Please work with us to make the game positive for the players.

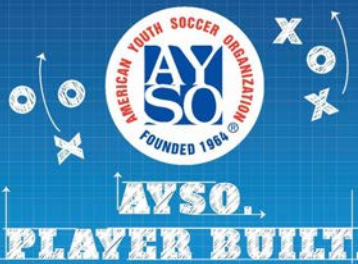


## REFEREES ARE ALWAYS NEEDED

- Reminder: In divisions 8U and above, without a certified referee to officiate the game, the game cannot be played

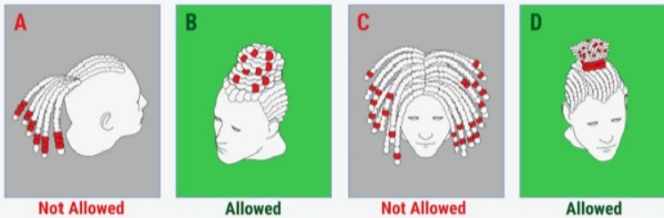

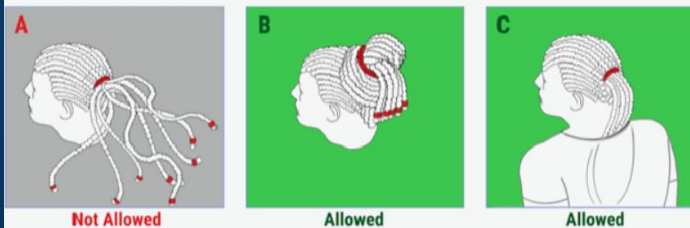


## CLARIFICATION ON HAIR BEADS, CLIPS, & ADORNMENTS



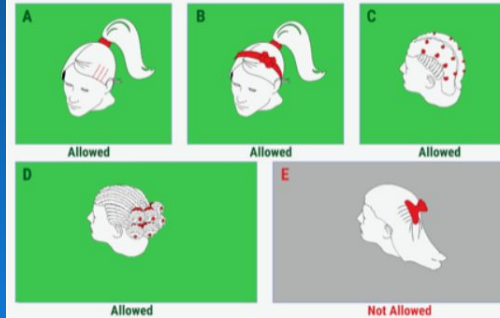
In pictures A and C, the hair beads worn by each player are not securely fastened to the head  
In pictures B and D, the hair beads worn are securely fastened to the head

### Hair adornment solutions



In picture A, the player cannot play with the hair adornment in the current position as it is not securely fastened to the head. Players in pictures B and C are allowed.

### Hair adornment solutions



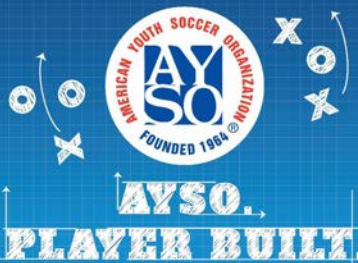
In pictures A, B, C & D the hair control devices are worn securely fastened and are allowed. In picture E, the hair device is not allowed as it is not securely fastened to the head.

### Hair Charms



Hair charms are considered jewelry, and per Law 4 would not be permitted.

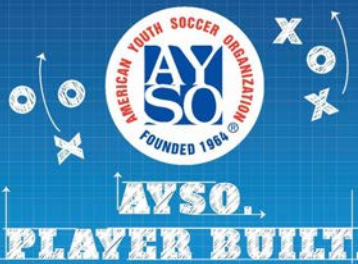

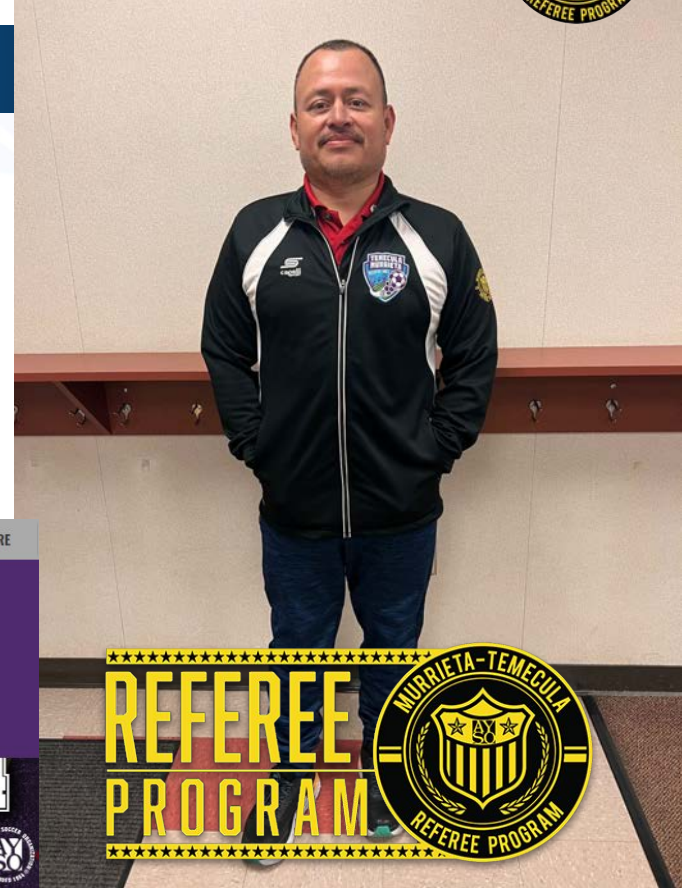

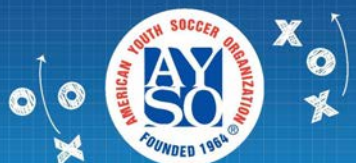

# SAFETY PROCEDURES

## RAIN POLICY

AYSO 1463 **does not** cancel games due to the rain. However, the City of Murrieta might. If games get canceled, Coaches will notify you. We will also update our Social Media pages and send out an email alert through Sports Connect.

**Note:** If there's thunder and lighting, play is stopped immediately and everyone should leave the field to a safe area (typically a car). Play cannot resume until 30 minutes after all thunder and lightning have stopped.

## HEAT POLICY

If the day is deemed hot, all games will be given an extra water break per quarter. Please make sure to bring LOTS of water during these days.

## GAME CANCELLATIONS

If make-up dates become available, parents will be notified





# SAFETY NOTES TO KEEP IN MIND

- **Non-Registered Youth / Volunteers cannot** participate in practices or Games (siblings cannot help during practices)
- Under **no circumstances** should **adults play in Scrimmages/Games**. That includes playing games with other adults or minors (including Coaches).
- Club Linesman - Not Covered by Insurance
- **Parents must remain on field with Children (10U & Under).**  
No drop-offs during practice
- Concerns: Feel free to discuss concerns with your Coaches & the Region.  
**I.e. Learning Disabilities** | The Region will work with you!
- **No clear identification of Players!** Clothing, backpacks, etc. must avoid displaying player names for safety reasons. Regarding **team banners**, names are OK as long as it's a first name only and it doesn't tie the name to a specific jersey number.

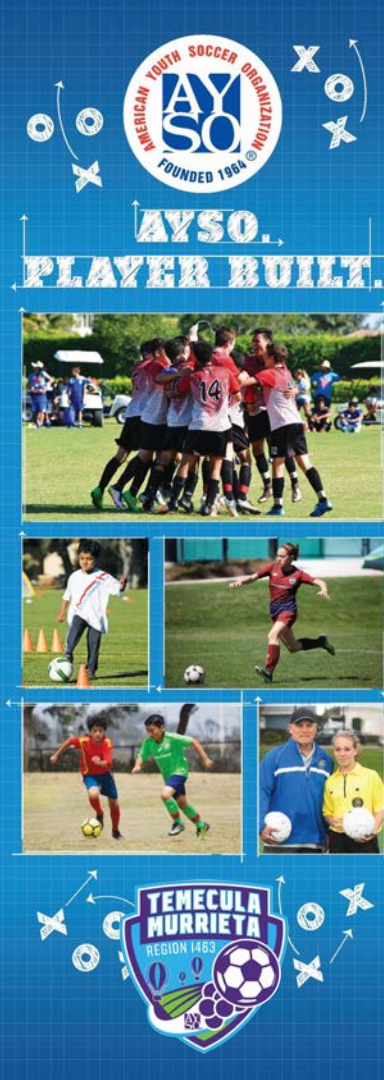

Will have Epic Buddies; Coaches may be on the field; (Parent or parent designee of majority age must be present for each player).

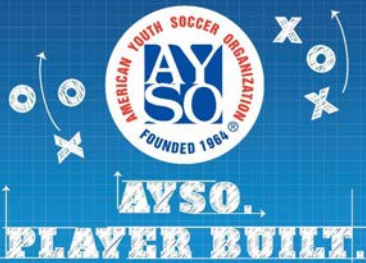

Build Out Line YouTube Video Explanation:

Promotes playing the ball out of the back in a less pressured setting.

Adds additional space and time for the team to build an attack **when play is resumed from a Goal Kick.**

Build-out lines are located in each half, halfway **between the halfway line and the Goal Area.**

During a Goal kick, opponents **must** retreat behind the Build Out Line **(Referees will help with this).**

Opponents may cross the BOL as soon as the ball is kicked and clearly moves.

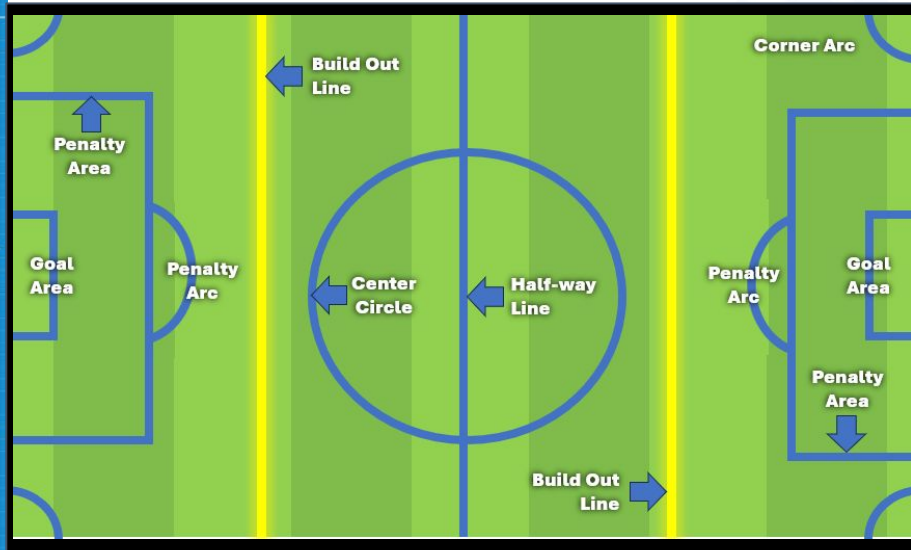

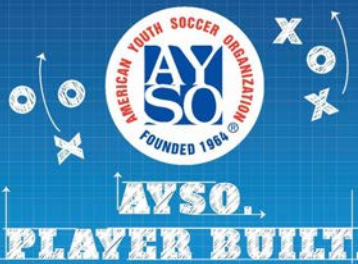
Adds additional space and time for the team to build an attack **when play is resumed from a Goal Kick or after a save from the Goalkeeper.**



In 10U, the BOL replaces the halfway line in judgement of **Offside Offenses**. Players cannot be penalized for an offside offense between the halfway line and BOL.

## 12U DIVISION - CALL-OUTS

- **60 mins practice**  
**2 Times a Week Maximum**
- **60 minute games / 9v9 Game**  
30 Min. Halves includes breaks
- Positions should be taught and **encouraged.**

## 14U DIVISION

90 mins practice / No more than 3 hours a week  
70 minute games (35 min halves) / 11v11 Game

### Big Ticket Items:

- Positions should be taught and **enforced**
- Goalkeepers: Can play all 4 Quarters
- Headers are allowed (Unless 12U Aged Player)
- Substitutions are only allowed during quarter break

## 16U GIRLS DIVISION

90 mins practice / No more than 3 hours a week  
80 minute games (40 min halves) / 11v11 Game

### Differences from 14U Division:

- Free substitutions are allowed in 16U+
- Game is played as two halves (not quarter breaks)

- Games may occur on Weeknights and/or Saturdays
