


AYSO VISION

POSITIVE COACHING


Coaches are required to coach using positive messages and tone while providing constructive criticism to help build a player's soccer skill development





WHAT IS AN AYSO VOLUNTEER?







RESPECT THE VOLUNTEERS

- Coaches and Referees are usually parents.
 They volunteer their time to help make your child's youth soccer experience a positive.
 These volunteers need your support, too!
- What Coaches and Referees don't need is your help in coaching from the sidelines.
 Please refrain from coaching during the games and practices.
- Do not enter the field unless called onto the field by the referee.
- Referees are not the "bad guys." They're volunteers, too, and need your support and encouragement. Treat them and their calls fairly and respectfully.















REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS

SAFE HAVEN COURSE

The course covers all of AYSO's philosophies on promoting safety, injury prevention as well as behaviors necessary to create a positive soccer experience.

CDC CONCUSSION COURSE

Volunteers will be given insight on the telltale signs of a concussion and know what to do in case one appears to occur.

SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST

Volunteers are provided to help recognize the signs and risk factors for SCA.



SAFESPORT COURSE

Volunteers are provided to help recognizing adult/minor misconduct awareness and abuse prevention

LIVE SCAN CERTIFICATION

Fingerprinting technology that scans for criminal history background checks



COACH / ASST. COACH CERTIFICATIONS

Coaches are required to complete certification up to the division they are coaching. Certs for older divisions require in-person training.

REFEREE CERTIFICATIONS

Volunteers are required to complete Regional Referee training to become certified as a Referee in AYSO.






VOLUNTEER POINTS PROGRAM

In order to qualify for the **Gem of the Valley** Cup, teams will need to earn Volunteer Points throughout the season. Teams can earn volunteer points in several different ways.

Tent Duty | Field Lining | Photographer |
Coach Certs | Refereeing | Referee Certs |
Goal Set-up | Become a Certified Team Parent

 All teams that meet the minimum requirements for Volunteer Points will be eligible to participate in the Gem of the Valley Cup. Seeding for the cup will be based on win/loss record, with total number of volunteer points being the tie-breaker if teams end up with the same record.

THE REFEREE'S ROLE

- The Referee is responsible for enforcing the Laws of the Game while keeping the game Safe, Fair, & Fun!
- In divisions 8U and above, without a certified referee to officiate the game, the game cannot be played
- No Certified Referee = No Game Played
- We are all Volunteers. We will make mistakes during a game. Please work with us to make the game positive for the players.





REFEREES ARE ALWAYS NEEDED

- Being a Referee in AYSO is a very rewarding volunteer experience. We always welcome people who want to become a referee.
- Reminder: In divisions 8U and above, without a certified referee to officiate the game, the game cannot be played
- JOIN THE TEAM! Help make sure the games can be played










YOUTH REFEREES

- We welcome players and their siblings to become referees
- Youth Referees must be <u>two years</u> older than any player in the game they are officiating
- All youth referees will be fully supported by the Region's Referee Mentor Program
- Youth Referees collect hours towards their required community service requirement
- Our Region has a ZERO Tolerance for dissent or abuse of a Youth Referee.

- Amazing program for new referees and/or youth referees!








PROTECTING OUR REFEREES

With referee abuse on the rise for youth and amateur matches, it's time to take a stand.

Referees are essential to soccer, but far too often risk their emotional and physical well-being in service to the game.

Win, lose, or draw, we're in this together.

When you take your anger out on the referee, everybody loses, and the call on the field still stands.

Referee abuse is damaging for everyone involved – and for the future of soccer.

Thank you for doing your part.

NON-PHYSICAL OFFENSES of gross misconduct, abuse, and / or assault

Harassment, Intimidation, Retaliation, Abusive, or Threatening (Non Physical) Language	4	
Aggression, Attacking, Derogatory, Cyberbullying, Doxing or Threatening (Physical / Violence) Language	6	6 - 24 Months
Offensive or Discriminatory Act	10	12 - 24 Months

PHYSICAL OFFENSES of gross misconduct, abuse, and / or assault

PHYSICAL*	MIN. GAMES	TIME
Minor or Slight Deliberate Touching	3	1 - 6 Months
Pushing, Grabbing, Pulling, Squeezing, Pinching, Lightly Slapping, Use of Object in Non Striking Manner, or Physical Property Damage	10	6 - 24 Months
Hitting, Punching, Elbowing, Kicking, Biting, Spiting, Choking, Tackling, Throwing or Use of Object or Any Part of Body (Forearm, Knee, Head) in a Striking Manner		12 Months - Lifetime

KEY PENALTY FACTORS

- Single offenses are at minimum the prescribed game penalty or time penalty for non red zone offenses
- Penalties can be both game and time depending on severity / circumstances
- Second time offenders receive double punishment
- Third time offenders receive a **lifetime** ban
- More than one offense at the same time is at least the punishment for the most serious offense
- Offenses against minors are automatically subject to a "minor multiplier" resulting in triple punishment
- One offense warning per league to be managed by states and leagues collaboratively
- Game consequences are inclusive of 1 game penalty for any red cards given
- Optionality for 50% penalty for first offense from a minor





SAFETY PROCEDURES

RAIN POLICY

AYSO 1463 **does not** cancel games due to the rain. However, the City of Murrieta might. If games get canceled, Coaches will notify you. We will also update our Social Media pages and send out an email alert through Sports Connect.


Note: If there's thunder and lighting, play is stopped immediately and everyone should leave the field to a safe area (typically a car). Play cannot resume until 30 minutes after all thunder and lightning have stopped.

HEAT POLICY

If the day is deemed hot, all games will be given an extra water break per quarter. Please make sure to bring LOTS of water during these days.

GAME CANCELLATIONS

If make-up dates become available, parents will be notified



SAFETY NOTES TO KEEP IN MIND

- Non-Registered Youth / Volunteers <u>cannot</u> participate in practices or Games (siblings cannot help during practices)
- Under no circumstances should adults play in Scrimmages/Games.
 That includes playing games with other adults or minors (including Coaches).
- Club Linesman Not Covered by Insurance
- Parents must remain on field with Children (10U & Under).
 No drop-offs during practice
- Concerns: I.e. Learning Disabilities
 Feel free to discuss concerns with your Coaches & the Region.
 The Region will work with you!
- No clear identification of Players! Clothing, backpacks, etc. must avoid displaying player names for safety reasons. Regarding team banners, names are OK as long as it's a first name only and it doesn't tie the name to a specific jersey number.

EQUIPMENT RELATED

EQUIPMENT LIST

AYSO 1463 provides uniforms - a Jersey, Shorts and Socks. Players are **required** to wear shin guards **underneath** socks. Cleats not required but **highly recommended**

- Soccer Balls
 - Schoolyard-8U: Size 3
 - o **10U-12U:** Size 4
 - 14U and above: Size 5
- Captain Armbands! Region Supplies bands

NOT ALLOWED

- No jewelry (Earrings, Watches, Necklaces)
 - Medical alert bracelets are the only exception (the bracelet must be taped down)
- No sunglasses are allowed unless they are prescription sunglasses
- No casts or splints even if they're padded and the player has been cleared by a doctor
 - Soft braces are ok No metal inserts
- No Hats with Hard Bills (no Baseball Hats) / Knit Caps OK for players on cold days
- No Noise Makers (Parents)





- Please do not sit behind Coach Staff or Goals Not Allowed!






GEM OF THE VALLEY CUP!

- All teams that fulfill our Volunteer Points requirements will be eligible for participation in the Cup





EPIC & SCHOOLYARD PROGRAMS

EPIC PROGRAM

The Epic Program (Everyone Plays In our Community) is specially designed to support players with special needs.

This program provides a quality soccer experience for children and adults whose physical or mental disabilities make it difficult to successfully participate in the core program.

Equipment: Shin guards are required; soccer cleats are optional; size 5 ball; occasionally play with a large ball (3 feet in diameter); have pinnies available.

Volunteers

Will have Epic Buddies; Coaches may be on the field; (Parent or parent designee of majority age must be present for each player).

Additional

Will play short sided games; four 10-minute guarters

SCHOOLYARD

Schoolyard focuses on GROUP Session Play where kids are provided engaging activities. It's a fun interactive session where players learn the game of soccer.







Build Out Line YouTube Video Explanation:

<u>Click This Link</u>

Promotes playing the ball out of the back in a less pressured setting.

Adds additional space and time for the team to build an attack when play is resumed from a Goal Kick.

Build-out lines are located in each half, halfway between the halfway line and the Goal Area.

During a Goal kick, opponents <u>must</u> retreat behind the Build Out Line (Referees will help with this).

Opponents may cross the BOL as soon as the ball is kicked and clearly moves.











10U DIVISION - CALL-OUTS

- 60 mins practice 2 Times a Week Maximum
- **50 minute games** (7v7 Game) (25 Min. Halves includes breaks)
- Goalkeeper is now Involved! Cannot play more than 2 Qtrs as GK
- Offside Law is Now in Effect! (Build-Out Line now used to help enforce)




Adds additional space and time for the team to build an attack when play is resumed from a Goal Kick or after a save from the Goalkeeper.

In 10U, the BOL replaces the halfway line in opponents' half of field in judgement of **Offside Offenses.** Players cannot be penalized for an offside offense between the halfway line and BOL.



12U DIVISION - CALL-OUTS

- 60 mins practice 2 Times a Week Maximum
- **60 minute games / 9v9 Game** 30 Min. Halves includes breaks
- Positions should be taught and encouraged.
- Goalkeepers: Cannot play more than 3 quarters as Keeper. Must play one quarter on the field. *This is NOT COMMON*
