Sideline Behavior

PLAYERS PLAY, COACHES COACH, PARENTS CHEER, REFEREES REF

Do not run up the score...if you go up by 6-7 goals please move your defense to offense, pass with your left foot and do 10 passes.

Don't let your parents coach your team! You are the coach and let them know. Keep the players at the coaching box. Parents want to coach them during the game.

Wait for the referee to call you on the field when the referee calls you only...just don't run out there

Please stay in your technical area (painted coaching box)

Any problems with your parents let the referee know and the tent after that if need be

Positive, Instructional and Encouragement


Keep your parents on your side of the field and don't let them by the goalies

Never leave a player alone at the field after games or practices

- 60 80 Practice should be 1 hour once a week.
- 10U -12U Practice should be 1 hour, twice a week.
- 14U- 16U Practice can be up to 1 ½ hours, twice a week.
- Be considerate of those around you. Don't take more space than necessary.
- Stick to your grid.
- Stick to your time.

Spring '24 French Valley Cup

- May 18
- 10U 14U
- Must have:
 - Referee points (min. 20 points)
 - 4 pts. Center (per game)
 - 2 pts. AR (per game)
 - Sportsmanship points (min. 60 points)
 - Player rating turned in
 - Coach must be certified at level they are coaching



Sportsmanship Points

Each 10U-14U team will be required to earn at least 60 Sportsmanship points to enter the *French Valley Cup*.

Teams can earn 9 points per game.



Loss of sportsmanship points may result in your team being denied entry in the *French Valley Cup*.

Don't run up scores!

Common ways teams lose points

- Caution or send-off to a player or coach
- Yelling at the referee
 - <u>Zero</u> tolerance regarding Youth Referees
- Running up the score!
 - Example: winning by more than 6 goals
- Sideline/Spectator poor sporting behaviors
 - Referees may deduct Sportsmanship Points for unacceptable behavior from the coach or sideline



When is it acceptable to dispute referee calls?

Referee calls on the field are not subject to dispute.

Team captains or coach may politely ask for clarification of a call however, referees are not obligated to clarify or explain their calls. Many do not out of interest of keeping the match moving.

If you need further clarification or discussion, contact the referee administrator. If a referee fails to appropriately apply the IFAB Laws Of The Game, the referee staff will determine the appropriate action or education opportunity regarding the referee.

Do Not Argue with the referees!!!

Referee Requirements

• 10U – 12U:


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- Each team will provide referee for game before or after
- Each team will provide AR for their game
- 14U 16U: Provide two AR's for Every Game
 - Board will provide center at minimum





U.S. Soccer's Player Development Initiatives (PDI's)

- No Offside between buildout line and halfway line
- No Heading 12U and below
- Build Out Line for 10U
- No Keeper Punting in 10U
- 6U kick in (no throw-in)
- 6U-8U Indirect Free Kicks only (No PK)



Check in Procedure

Coaches

- Must have properly completed game card
- Can be found under Coaches tab on AYSO1508.com
- Each week, must check in at board tent prior to match to receive sportsmanship medal
- Coaches should check in the log book & monitor Points/Status

Referees

- Check in 20 minutes before Match
- Full Uniform
- Return completed game card to board tent after each game





Be Prepared...

- Know the Laws of the Game (become a referee)
- Be Respectful of the Referees
- Know Your Players Health Conditions
- Minimize Coaching During the Game
 - Coach at the half not between quarters
 - One minute between quarters clock runs!!
- Every Player plays ³/₄ of the Match
- Keeper Rule
 - $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Game for 10U (must play $\frac{1}{4}$ on the field)
 - ³/₄ of the Game for 12U (must play ¹/₄ on the field)


