### Questions and Answers

Q: What is going to be different between this season and seasons from the past?

A: Players: No coin toss. Visitors kick-off, Home team selects goal to defend. Sharing of equipment is not recommended. No sharing of water bottles or personal protective equipment (PPE). No handshakes/high-5's. After the game, applaud the players and coaches. Fist bumps/elbows are not recommended. Parents: When possible maintain social distancing. Face coverings are recommended (not required).

Q: What do I do if I get a letter from my child's school concerning a COVID-19 issue?

A: AYSO Region 84 recommends that you follow the same guidance for practices and games as directed in the letter. If your child is allowed to attend school, they are allowed to attend practices and games. If your child is required to quarantine for 14 days, they should not attend practices or games for the same 14 days.

Q: What if my child has had a Close Contact event or has contracted COVID-19?

A: In either case, contact your child's coach immediately. They will then fill out the proper paperwork to submit to Region 84. Region 84 will then flow the information down to the various players or teams that could be impacted.
