

## Safety Rules for

### COACHES and ASSISTANT COACHES

#### All AYSO COACHES/ASSISTANT COACHES...

- Must be appropriately certified and trained.
- Will be provided with hand sanitizer for team use.
- Will be provided with AYSO training equipment (balls, cones, first aid kit) Coaches must also carry a paper copy of every player's registration form at all times.
- Are requested to wear a cloth mask or face covering when on the field
- Will personally answer the COVID-19 Questionnaire and check their own temperature prior to arrival at the field for every practice or AYSO event. If a coach is positive for any symptoms or meets other exposure criteria, the coach must NOT go to the field, and practice can be led by the assistant coach or cancelled if there is no assistant coach. If a coach tests positive for COVID-19 or has been exposed to a COVID-19 positive individual, the coach must immediately notify the Safety Director at [safety@sanbrunoayso.org](mailto:safety@sanbrunoayso.org) and the commissioner at [commissioner@sanbrunoayso.org](mailto:commissioner@sanbrunoayso.org)
- If you are informed that a team player has tested positive for COVID-19 or has been exposed to a COVID-19 positive individual, the coach must immediately notify the Safety Director at [safety@sanbrunoayso.org](mailto:safety@sanbrunoayso.org) and the commissioner at [commissioner@sanbrunoayso.org](mailto:commissioner@sanbrunoayso.org). The confidentiality of the exposed player must be maintained. The commissioner will inform players of a possible COVID-19 exposure and if practices need to be cancelled. The coach will be required to file an incident report.
- If a player appears to have COVID symptoms at a practice/game and is not feeling well, the coach will have the player put on his/her mask, and sit separately from others, while contacting the parents.
- Be a positive role model, and create a safe and fun environment in our new normal!
