Team N	I understand I need to have a parent meeting to inform the parents about the season & my expectations. I understand that the parents of my team must sign a Parent Code of Conduct Form.  I understand that two league approved background checked & safe-havened adults need to be at the field at all times (this could include a registered team parent).  I will not invite a person that has not been directly approved by Region 1455 to help in any manner on the field, even if they are a "nice person" or if they tell me they used to be a coach.  I will make sure that I am wearing my Region issued coach shirt (or badge) during practices and games.  I will not allow a non-AYSO player to practice on my field or with my team.  I realize due to liability reasons, no adults can play on the field with the players.  I will only use registered players from my team & agree to not alter rosters/line up cards if I am short-handed. (For 8U and below, opposing team players only may be borrowed).

Sideline  Initial	I understand that it is my responsibility as a coach to keep my parents in check. Parents should only be cheering & not providing instructions to the players, nor communicating with the referees. I will communicate this at the team meeting & throughout the season, if needed.  I will not enter the field of play (stepping over the sideline) unless a referee signals for me & I will remind parents that they are not allowed to enter the field, as well.  I will not engage with players from the opposing team, unless it is a positive comment (Coaches manage behavior of their own team ONLY).  If I have any issue with the opposing coach, I will contact our RCA (coach administrator) to follow up with the issue.  I will remind my parents that dogs are not allowed at the fields (even if being held) & will ask for the dog to be removed immediately as this can affect our permit status.  I acknowledge that earrings are not allowed to be worn on the field, even if bandaged/ covered. I will make sure my team follows these rules.	
Referee	I understand that this is a 100% volunteer organization & each team needs (10u & older) to provide referees to cover other games during the season. A certain amount of points, which represent coverage must be met by parent volunteers on your team, or your team will not qualify for the <i>INVITATIONAL</i> post season tournaments. No exceptions.  Referees are not perfect. I understand that they are all volunteers & without them, the game would be canceled. I will show the utmost respect to the referees that volunteer their time for my game. If I have a complaint, I will email our RRA to handle it.  There is ZERO tolerance for adult or youth referee abuse. No negative comments are allowed to or near a youth referee. I understand that I will be brought in by the disciplinary team & suspended if it is found that I	

	abused a referee in any way. I am allowed to ask what is the call, but not to question the call, nor try to argue	
	it. I understand that if I am ejected from a game by a referee or board member, there is a minimum mandatory	
	suspension for the next game.	
	I understand that I am also responsible for my parents on the sideline when it comes to the treatment of referees & will pledge to protect ALL referees.

Practices:		
	I understand that I may only practice at the assigned time & field.	
	I understand that I may use the goals at the field, but must lock them up after practice.  I understand that goal safety is a priority and will remind my players (or any other children) not to climb or	
	hang on the goals or the nets.	
	I understand that I should end practices by 5 minutes before the next practice begins.	
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Games		
	I understand that I should have my players arrive at a 30 minute minimum before the start of the game (depends on age of players).	
	I understand that most games cannot be rescheduled. Due to how many people rescheduling affects and	
	when I get my schedule, I will immediately let the league know if there are any big issues (such as scheduling	
	conflicts for coaches of more than one team). It is NOT ok to ask for a reschedule due to missing a key player	
	or having to play short.	
	I understand that I need approval from RCA to cancel a game.	
	I understand that I may not alter the format or rules of the game.	
	I understand that ALL players play 3 quarters before any play 4 and that I should rotate 2 quarter players	
	throughout the season (if the numbers don't allow for 3)	
	I understand that in 8U and below there are no standings kept and in 10U+ teams only get credit for goals	
	against (there is never a good reason to run up the score).	
	I understand that blowouts are NEVER needed & I will keep the game from becoming a blowout with no	
	more than a six goal differential, while showing respect to the weaker team.

	As a coach, I agree to focus on development over winning.	
	As a coach, I will remember that there are two sets of kids playing the game & will take a proactive approach	
	to avoid any blowouts during the season.	
	I will remember at all times that I am coaching children & expected to provide a fun, fair & safe environment	
	for the kids.	
	I will contact the proper Region 1455 board members if there is any issue I think needs addressing.	
	I understand that ALL tournaments in the Region, Area and Section are INVITATIONAL tournaments and	
	participation is not automatic. Participation is by invitation of those events/tournaments only.	
	I realize that this is youth rec soccer, not the World Cup.
