## Pre-game checklist

Pre-game instructions to ARs (10U+)
Inspect field for hazards and that goals are in place and weighted down (not applicable for PVC goals)
Check players equipment: Wearing the 5 S's, no jewelry, socks over shinguards
Gather ball(s) and check for inflation.
Place extra balls next to goals (10U+).
Call for captains and carry out coin toss: visitors call toss, winner chooses direction or to take kick off.
Teams switch sides after halftime and other team kicks off.
Start game on time!

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Opponents must be at least 2 yards from the ball on throw-ins and pass-ins; 5-8 yards on other restarts.

Fouls summary - 10U and below

Direct free kick (DFK) fouls can only occur:

By a <u>player</u> Against an <u>opponent</u> While ball is in play

Penalized for action done carelessly, recklessly or with excessive force (7)

P: Pushes

J: Jumps


C: Charges

S: Strikes (or attempt)


K: Kicks (or attempt)

T: Tackles

T: Trips (or attempt)



Penalized for action (5)



S: Spits at or bites any person

H: Holds

I: Impedes w/contact

H: Handball offence

T: Throws an object at ball, opponent or match official.

Most common DFK fouls committed by younger players

- 1. Kicks, or attempts to kick, an opponent
- 2. Trips, or attempts to trip, an opponent
- 3. Pushes an opponent
- 4. Holds an opponent
- 5. Handles the ball deliberately

## Indirect Free Kick (IFK) Fouls

Goalkeeper inside own penalty area:

Takes more than **6 seconds** to release ball from hand control (rarely called)

Regains hand control prior to touch by another player (double touch)

Touches ball with hands after deliberately kicked by team-mate

Touches ball with hands after throw-in by team-mate

## Player:

Plays in a dangerous manner (most common IFK foul by younger players)

Impedes the progress of an opponent w/out contact

Prevents goalkeeper from releasing ball from his/her hands

Other offenses punishable by an IFK

Keeper punts the ball (10U)

Player deliberately heads the ball (12U and below)

Any foul by 6U or 8U player.
