




Every Team Needs






Important Things To Remember

- 1. Keep it fun.
- 2. Parents and Spectators comments must be positive and not give instructions. No one may stand behind the goal lines.
- 3. Coaches are not on the field and stay on the touchline (side line) near the middle of the field.
- 4. Home team's referee will referee the game.
- 5. Games are played with 4 players on each team. If the other team is missing players please let one of your players be a hero and help them out by playing on their team.
- 6. Please have your team arrive early enough so that they can practice 30 minutes before the game. The game will begin at 9:25 am. Each half is 16 minutes.
- 7. Kick off is from the middle of the field and defending players must be 10 feet away.
- 8. Players do not switch sides at half time.
- 9. The other team will kick off after a goal is scored.
- 10. Let them play. Only restart the game with a kick in if they go too far off the field.
- 11. All restarts are kick ins from the Touch Line (side line)
- 12. There are no goalkeepers. Please let all of your players attack when your team is attacking and all players defend when your team is defending. It is okay to have one player positioned near the half. No goal tending.
- 13. We do not keep score. If one team scores a lot more goals make sure to give the other team goal scoring opportunities. You can move the kickoff closer to their goal or simply roll the ball out to the players near their goal and let them score. The emphasis at this age are ball skills, learning to pass the ball, learning to tackle the ball and working as a team.






Home Team Sits on the Left (**H**) Away team Sits On The Right (**A**)








