

Background Check - You should have already received an invitation from TheAdvocates@
SterlingVolunteers.com. Please follow the link to complete your Background Check ASAP. Due to County, State and Federal reporting, Background Check Processing can take up to 10 business days.
Self disclosures can add an additional 5 business days.

Access to Training - You will access the training system from this page by clicking the "AYSOU" button next to your volunteer record. You will be automatically logged in to the training system.

Safesport - to access your FREE training, that will update your AYSO status, please use this link to enroll: https://bafesporttrained.org/?KeyName=tsVVWo36Xa6PS3bSNzOug. You do not need to upload your Safesport results unless you are supplying a completed certificate from July 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021. Safesport will automatically update your profile, generally within 2 hours of completion.

Note: Youth Volunteers (anyone under the age of majority in your state) are <u>not required</u> to take this training.
