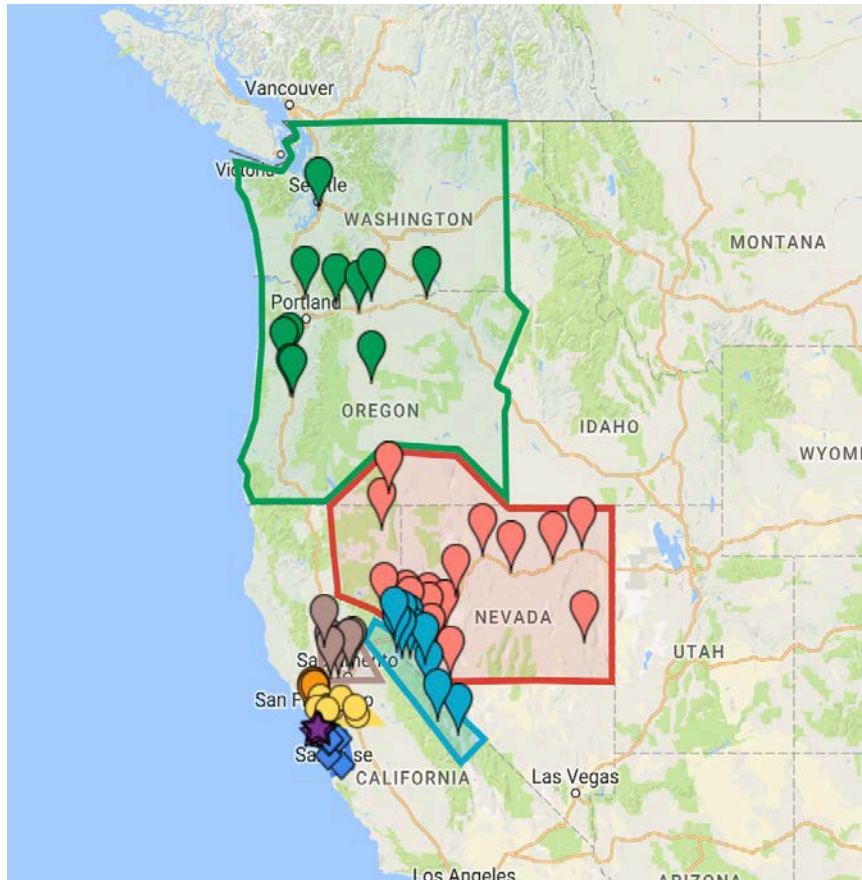

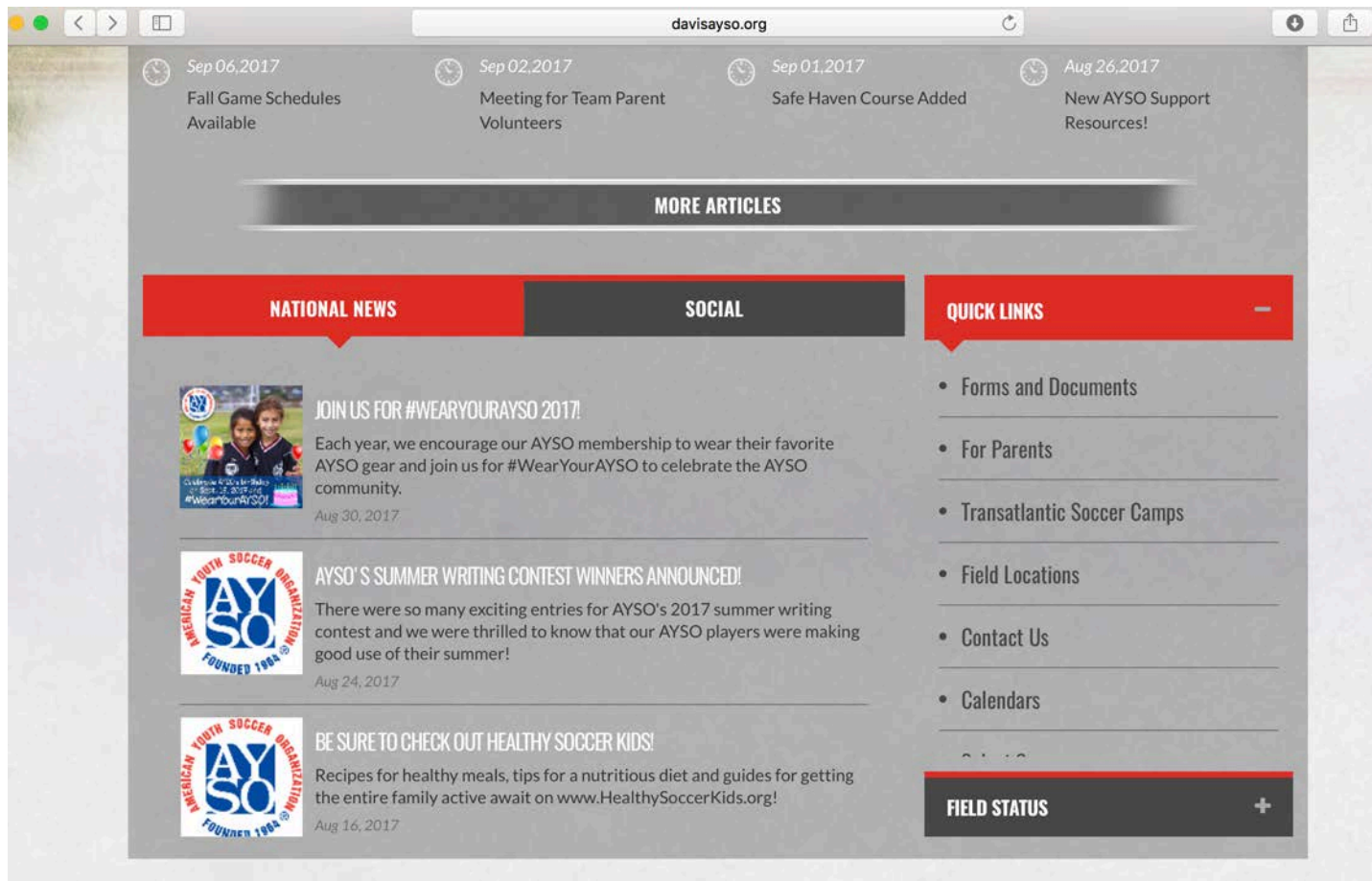
Set up and take down - first & last team to play on the field

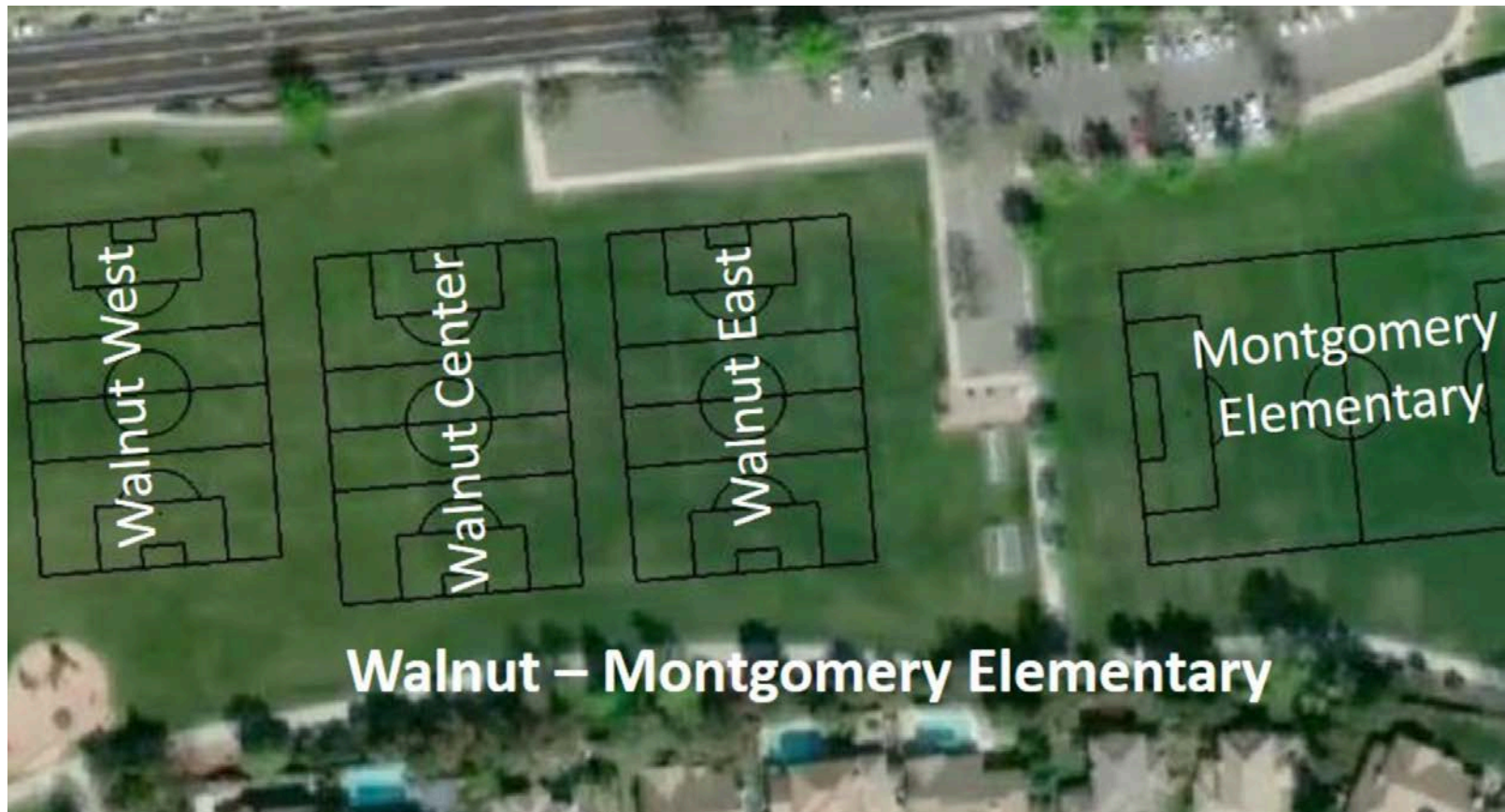

Spectators Role

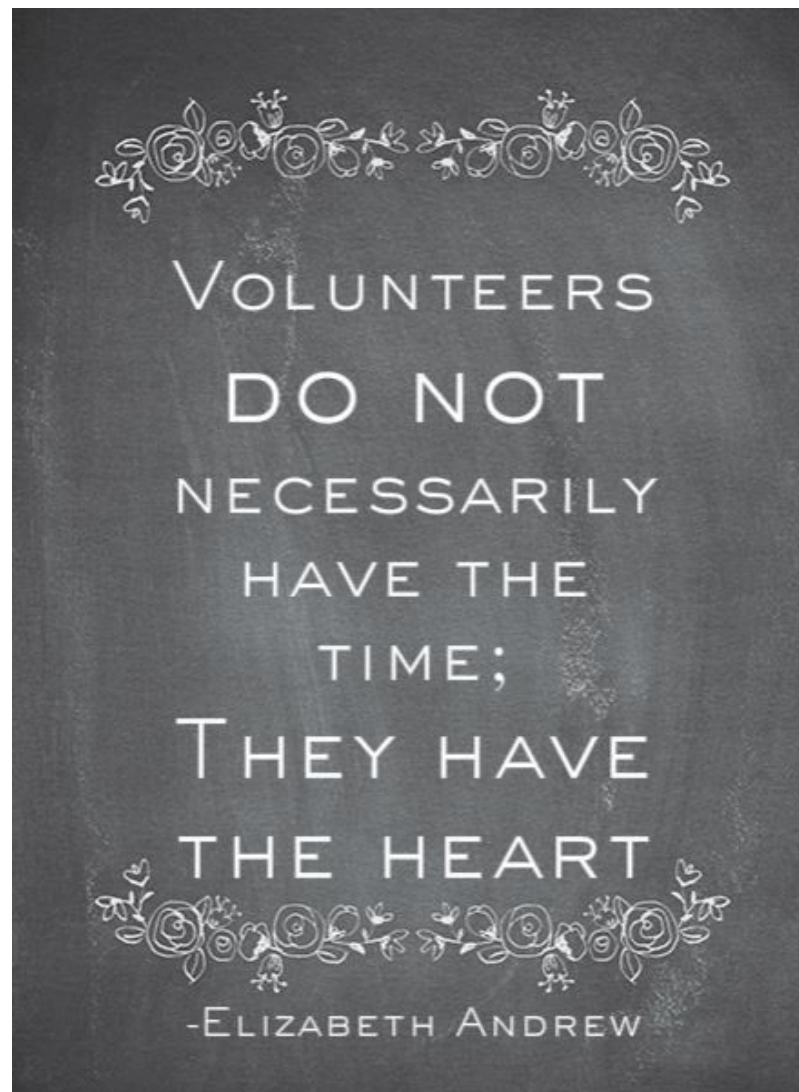
- No verbal comments to players, referees or coaches
- Encourage to clap and cheer for both teams

Team Parent Role

- Talk to the parents of your team
- Encourage parents to turn ALL Saturdays into a positive and fun learning environment for ALL players
- Remind parents – Referee's are volunteer parents

- Change division name
 - Was U 8 - Now 8 and Under or 8U
- Field size change
- Small sided Games - 8U and below. No keeper, 4 V 4, No throw ins, No off sides

Wisconsin Longitudinal Study

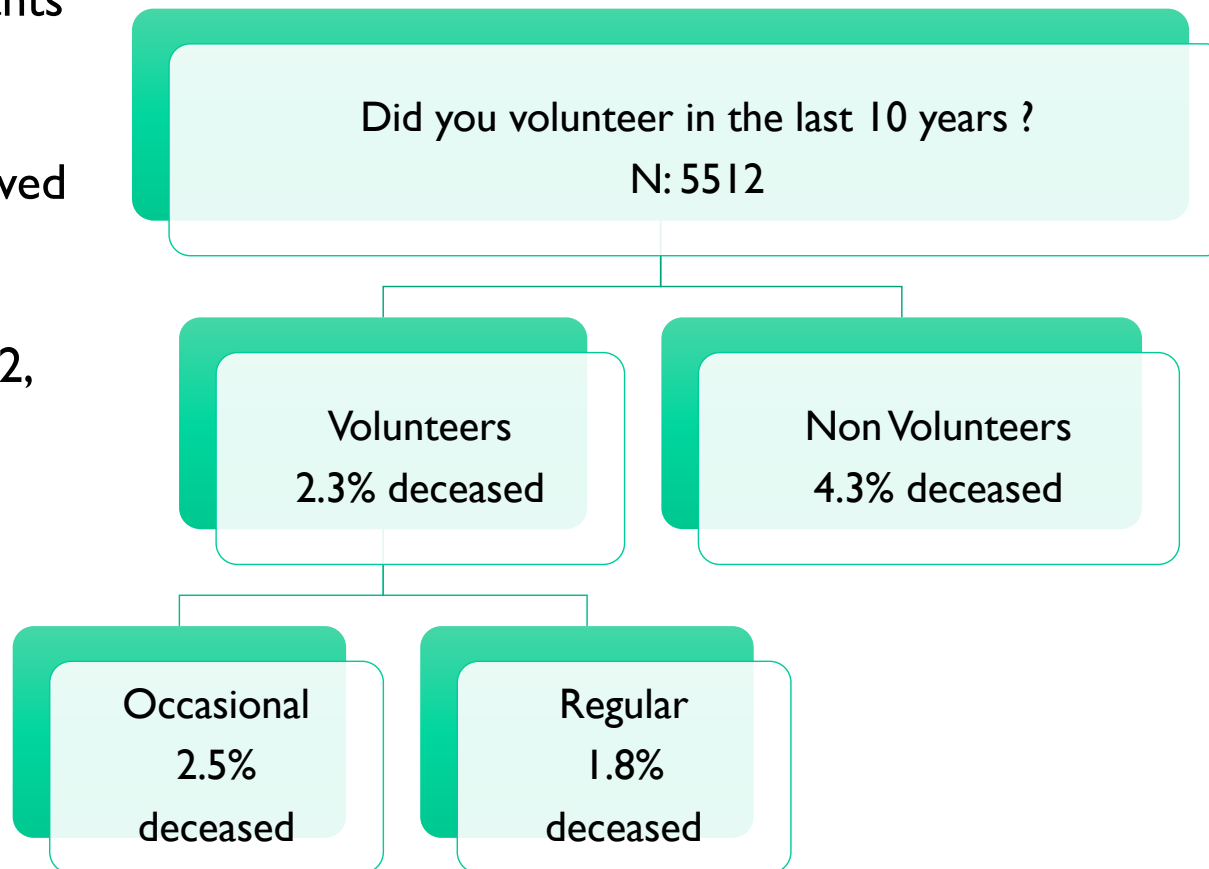
