
## Ala Puumalu Field Procedures



10U & 12U - Middle Field

### Field Set Up

- Home (Aiea) teams that have first game of the day should have their set up crew (2-3 people) there
  about an hour before the first game to paint and set up the field.
- Equipment for the field (paint and paint machines, corner flags, nets and equipment bucket, wheels for goals) will be delivered about an hour to 45 minutes prior to game time. Equipment buckets to contain 1 hammer, 10 pegs, referee flags and cones. The equipment is normally stored in the lower storage area and help may be needed to move the equipment from the storage room to the field. Goals are chained to the fence and will need to be moved into position. Since goals are heavy, 4 people should be used to move the goals.
- Both teams should help move and set up goals.

## Painting tips

- 1) To better see the existing lines, have the sun at your back.
- 2) If lines are hard to see, try looking down field and targeting visible line with paint machine
- 3) Walk at a steady pace for straighter lines
- 4) Remember to paint penalty arcs, penalty mark, center circle, center mark, corner arcs and coaches boxes (6 ft from touch line and 24 ft from center),

# Team Set Up

- Visiting team to set up on the makai side of the field, home on the mauka side of the field.
- Coaches and players to remain in the coaches box (technical area) and parents and other spectators to remain outside the box.
- Spectators should not be directly behind either goal line (National Rules Regs G.4).
- o If setting up a tent, it should be at least 8 feet away from touchline.
- Only coaches coach Parents & Supporters cheer.


### Referees & Team Responsibilities

 Referee crew (3 person team) should be there 30 minutes prior to the game to brief each other and inspect field. All teams are expected to fulfill their referee duties.

- Referees to turn in completed game cards to the referee tent in between the two fields after the game.
   If referees need assistance, check with referee tent.
- Before the game, check field for condition and goals to make sure they are safe. Cones in the equipment bucket can be used to mark unsafe field locations.

### • Field Breakdown

- o After last game, both teams to help breakdown and put away goals against the fence.
- o Collect all 5 pegs from each goal and return to the bucket.
- o Collect 4 corner flags
- Put nets in net bag 2 per bag
- o Bring equipment to the sidewalk for pick up.
- o Get the parents involved in helping
