MILILANI SUMMER CLASSIC MINI GAMES TOURNAMENT



Hello AYSO Section 7 Regions! AYSO Region 119 is proud to invite your teams to the Mililani Summer Classic

Mini Games Tournament Memorial Day Weekend, Sat & Sun May 27-28, 2023

Scope:	AYSO Section – open to AYSO teams from Section 7.
When:	Tournament dates are Saturday, May 27, and Sunday, May 28, 2023
Where:	The tournament will be held at Maka`unulau Community Park (16 Acres)
Who:	 AYSO boys, girls and coed teams in age divisions 10U and 12U. Note that Coed teams must play in the boys division. Gold, Silver, Bronze and Core/In-House teams are eligible to participate, and the best effort will be made to place teams in pools/brackets of like ability. All players must have registered and played in ½ of the most recent Fall or Winter Season.
What:	Tournament format: • 10U will be 5v5 with two 10-minute halves, free subbing, and no offside calls. • 12U will be 6v6 with two 12-minute halves, free subbing and no offside calls. • Every player must play at least half of each mini game. • There will be four (4) pools of four (4) teams for each gender in a division. • 10U Maximum roster size = 10 • 12U Maximum roster size = 12
	 Each team will play three (3) mini games AND two (2) TopTekkers challenges on Saturday, such as diamond dribbling, with each player completing a 30 to 60-second challenge with the final score for a challenge being the combined total of all players on a team.
	3 points for a mini games win; 1 point for a tie; 0 points for a loss.
	2 points will be awarded to the winning team in a TopTekkers challenge.
	Sunday's format will be playoff games and one (1) TopTekkers challenge per team.
	Note that Saturday's outcome will determine a team's playoff category status on Sunday. ALL teams can participate on Sunday.
Why:	The Mini Games format focuses on individual and team ball control, field vision, and communication in a fast-paced environment. The TopTekkers Challenges add a skills development component.
Awards:	Winners of Division Championship games and Sportsmanship will be awarded medals, among other recognition.

Entry Fee, Refunds:	 Entry fee and referee deposit must accompany the tournament application and will be returned if the application is not accepted. Please send 2 Region checks (no personal checks), one each for team entry and referee deposit. TEAM FEES - 10U = \$150.00; 12U = \$175.00 If the tournament cannot be held due to weather or other conditions beyond the control
Referee Fee, Refunds:	of the tournament host, a refund, less \$50.00 will be issued. REFEREE DEPOSIT: \$100.00. Make region checks payable to Mililani AYSO Region 119. Refundable within 14 days of the tournament if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide One (1) qualified CENTER REFEREE to cover a minimum of 2 mini games during the tournament.
	Should a team's referees fail to appear for any of their assignments, a portion of their referee deposit (\$50.00 per game) may be forfeited.
Rules:	A full set of tournament Rules & Regulations will be posted soon on the tournament website, www.mililaniayso.org.
Acceptance:	The application deadline is Saturday , May 6 , 2023 . All teams will be notified within 48 hours of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.
