Approve previous minutes (Sturmer):

# Apparel Sales (Sturmer/Taylor on behalf of Dramazos):

 Plan to sell all day at evals. Fancy Stitch will also be at evals to print names on apparel. Signup genius for shifts went out several weeks ago. Volunteers still needed.

# Long Term Projects (Gagne):

- Will assemble a donation list for DLL needs. Lists will be available as a handout at Evals and there will be a poster to hang at evals. Members could also donate funds toward a specific project. A continuously updated donation list will also be website.
- (Kirkey) Close on finalizing a contract. Has been working with Sean Burton and the second draft back from Burton was a significant improvement. Deadline has been set of April 1, 2015 to get finalized and signed.
  - Contract Framework:

- For 7 years allowing access to all Mill Creek and Creekside fields from April –August. Schools have use 2 days a week on designated days and fields.
- \$10,000 per year, plus what money we put in to them. Significant discount if you look at hourly rate.
- DLL maintains the fields but that is not exclusive.
- Kirkey to ask if can be agreed to have a school employee drag fields 1-2 times/week. Difficult for coaches and parents to drag to Little League standards.
- Dexter Schools are suppling chalk up to \$900 and will mow the fields.
- Kirkey to talk to Boobyer about signs for fields.
- Durliat talked about lightening detectors put on Long Term project wish list. Weather bug affiliated with Little League.
   Remove units from long-term project. Fuson to bring ideas for designated DLL app to use to next update.

# Baseball update (Bryson):

- Presented a list of coaches to be approved. Bryson and Guinta chose those with the most experience. At Majors level, all coaches who volunteered were selected accept one. Sturmer read Rosevelt's email on behalf of Rosevelt asking BOD to consider accepting the Majors coach who did not get offer a position.

- Baseball/Softball Draft Clarification (Pnacek):
  - BOD discussed and it was clarified that 1 coach is selected who will select an assistant after the draft.
- Discussion re: playing outside of age group in Baseball (All):
  - Those players interested in evaluating to play in a division above what the Dexter DLL designates by age will be considered. Eval criteria TBD.
  - Few on BOD would like to prevent any evaluating into an "older" division.
  - Arguments made for why those players who are in the same grade but not the same age should be allowed to evaluate up to an older division if they had been able to do so throughout their first 6 years in Little League and meet criteria.
