Executive Meeting Report: Nothing to report. Noted that Rec registration is now open for the cost of \$40 dollars due to the club's anniversary. 25 people have registered to date. Publicity in the schools should begin next week.

Treasurer's Report: Balance of \$51,015. Travel teams who have asked to be reimbursed for winter practice space have been reimbursed, still waiting on several teams to submit receipts.
