T-Ball Rules - Tournament

The T-Ball Division will follow all Wyandotte Braves Baseball and Softball rules with these exceptions.

- 1) A minimum of 7 players are required to play the game. A team with less than 7 players will forfeit the game.
- 2) Players will be pitched to by the coach. Live pitching for up to 6 pitches. After 6 pitches if the player has not put the ball into play, then the ball will be placed on the tee so it can be hit by the player.
- 3) When batting a strikeout is not possible.
- 4) The offensive team will bat until the defensive team records 3 outs or the travesty rule is reached.
- 5) Travesty rule: The batting team may not score more than five (5) runs in any half inning.
- 6) Runners may advance one base when a batted ball remains on the infield. Runners may advance only one extra base if the batted ball reaches the outfield grass. Runners will not advance on over throws.
- 7) If a runner is called out, they will return to the dugout.
- 8) All players will play defensively; no player shall be left on the bench except for an injury.
- 9) When a player is playing the pitcher's position, they will be positioned even or behind the pitching rubber. Players playing an infield position shall not be positioned more than 10 feet in front of the baseline.
- 10) The defensive team can record outs by tagging the base runner, via a force out, or catching a ball hit in the air.
- 11) Once 3 outs are attained or the travesty rule is reached, teams are to change up. Unlike the regular season all players on the team do not have to bat every inning.
- 12) Time limit is 45 minutes. A new inning will not start after the time limit has been reached. If time limit is reached after the inning has started that inning will be the last inning and will be played till complete.
- 13) One game official will be on the field to call the outs and track the time limit.
- 14) In the event multiple teams forfeiting are impacting advancement in the tournament bracket, the losing team with the most recorded outs will advance to fill the bracket spot. This requires all teams to keep a book and record the outs.
